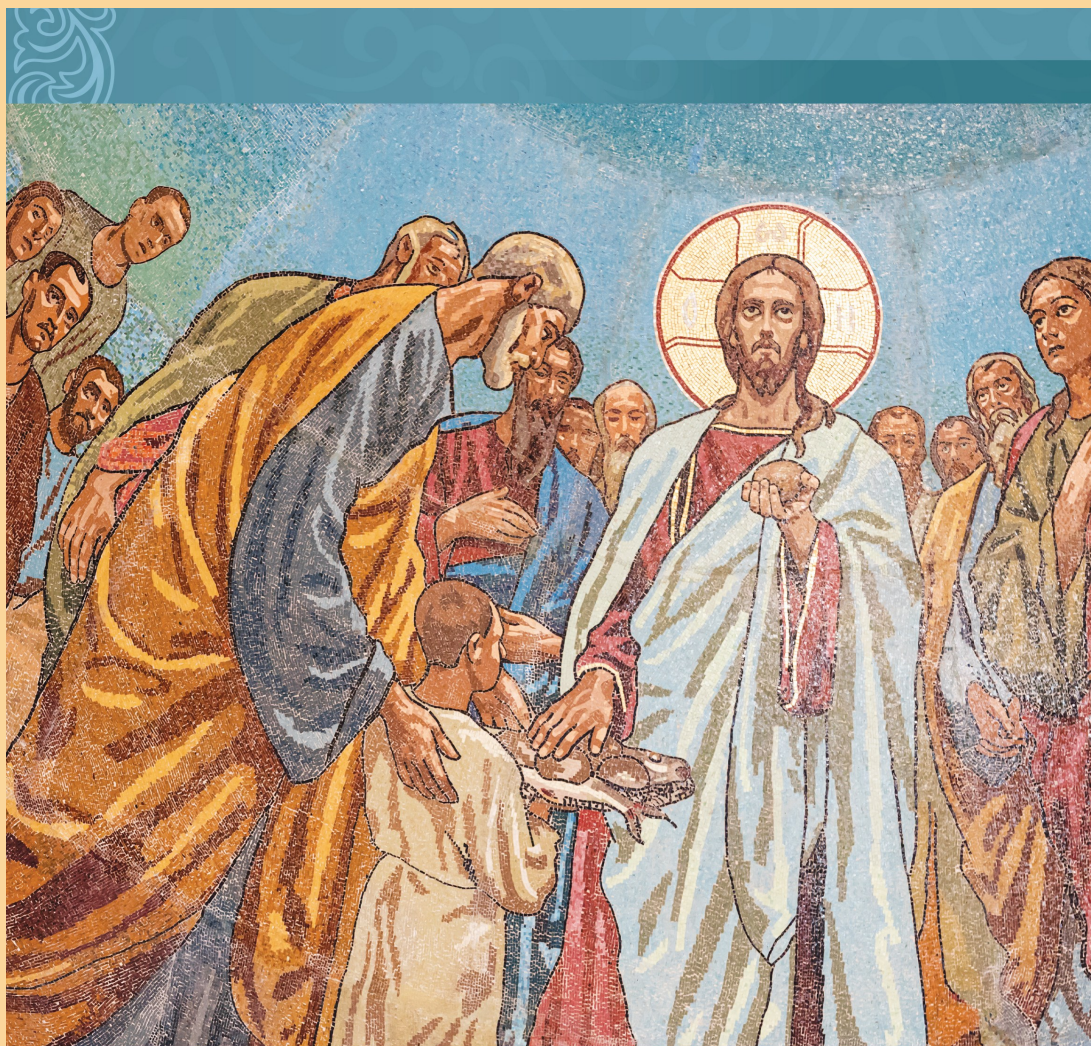

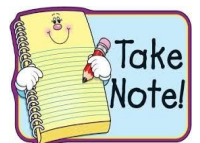
VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL "GOD'S WONDER LAB"

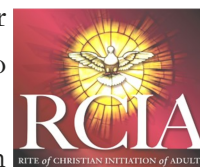
