Why are you charging an out-of-pocket fee?

Put simply, the Medicare rebate has not kept up with the rising cost of providing healthcare services. That has led to 65 percent of medical practices in Australia charging all of their patients out-of-pocket fees.

It was a difficult decision however rising costs of wages, insurance, supplies and equipment has meant that the Medicare rebate does not cover the cost of running the practice.

We will still be bulk billing patients who have concession cards or who are children aged 16 years and under.

Who is exempt from the gap fee?

Our doctors will still offer bulk billed appointments for concession card holders:

- · Pensioner Card
- · DVA (Department of Veteran Affairs)
- · Health Care Card
- · Children aged 16 and under
