



NRL NT Club Expense Reimbursement Program

Purpose and application

The NRL NT club expense reimbursement program is available to NRL NT affiliated clubs and associations. The program provides for a reimbursement of “one-off” club expenses of up to \$2,000 (ex GST) per financial year i.e. 1st November to 31st October.

The program aims to reward and support NRL NT clubs and associations for their ongoing commitment to improving their club. Clubs and Associations must be compliant with all relevant authorities (including the NRL NT) with no accounts outstanding to be eligible to apply.

Key dates

NRL NT affiliated clubs and affiliations are able to apply from 1st April each year, all applications must be received by 31st August each year.

What can you apply for?

Expenses that can be reimbursed must provide for an ongoing benefit to the club or association.

Examples of items include:

- Club laptop or tablet.
- High cost training equipment, tackle bags, bump pads.
- Club trailer.
- Implementation of club website.

The annual club expense reimbursement program may include expenses from more than one type of expense or supplier.

What you can't apply for?

You are unable to apply for recurrent expense funding, these include:

- Club honorariums (Salaries, wages)
- Team uniforms or personal training equipment.
- Minor or short-life equipment, strapping tape, ice,
- Operational or core business activities such as accounting and audit fees, licencing fees,

How can I apply?

NRL NT affiliated clubs and associations are required to provide a tax invoice to the “ARLC NT Limited” during the advised application period detailing their contact details, ABN, banking details and noting “Club expense reimbursement program”. Clubs and associations must also provide/attach a copy of the original invoice for the expense incurred.
