SHOP-SES IS FREE MONEY FOR OUR PARISH

SHOP-SES is a pre-paid card program in which the parish can purchase store gift cards at a discount. By selling the cards at face value, the parish can generate additional funds without costing the parishioners additional money. Cards are used as cash at the various stores. All you need to do is purchase them prior to making your regular purchases. A list of cards immediately available can be found on the parish website <https://www.sesnaperville.org/shop-ses>.

Last year SHOP-SES generated over **\$2,450** for the parish. Since SHOP-SES started in January 2011, the program has generated over **\$70,000** for the parish. This happened \$1.00 at a time by parishioners using the SHOP-SES program.

“Addiction is a treatable, chronic medical disease involving complex interactions among brain circuits, genetics, the environment, and an individual’s life experiences. People with addiction use substances or engage in behaviors that become compulsive and often continue despite harmful consequences.”

American Society of Addiction Medicine

- ♦ Addictive behavior can come in many forms, more than drugs or alcohol. It can be smoking, gambling, shopping, video games, eating, using improper language...any activity in which the person engaged in the activity is impulsed to continue the activity without the ability to stop.

The causes of the addictive behavior may be biology, psychological, or caused by the environment in which someone lives.

There is hope! We have a tremendous number of resources and therapists at our disposal to manage addictions.

In Family Faith Formation this month, we are learning to pray to our Blessed Mother. We do not adore Mary as we do God, but we do honor her, as her Son honored her, for her special and unique role in His plan of salvation. As we grow closer to Mary and the power of her maternal intercession for us, we must acknowledge four Dogmas of the Catholic Church concerning Mary.

Dogmas are lights along the path of faith; they illuminate it and make it secure. Dogmas are truths of the faith contained in Divine Revelation. They are binding, infallible, and irrefutable when confirmed and solemnly proclaimed by the ecclesiastical authority: The Pope.



The Four Dogmas of Mary:

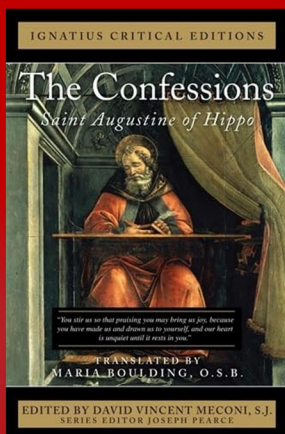
Divine Motherhood: Proclaimed by the Council of Ephesus (AD 431). Mary is called the “Mother of God” or in Greek “Theotokos” (Birth giver of God.) It affirms that Mary is the Mother of God because she gave birth to Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully human.

Perpetual Virginity: Defined at the Lateran Synod (649 AD). Mary was and is Virgin before, in and after Christ’s birth. Jesus Christ was Mary's only child. The so-called "brothers and sisters" are close relations.

Immaculate Conception: Proclaimed by Pope Pius IX (1864). By the special grace of the Almighty Father, Mary was kept free of every stain of original sin. From her beginning Mary was exceptionally holy and in constant union with the sanctifying grace of the Holy Spirit.

The Assumption: Proclaimed by Pope Pius XII (1950). Mary was taken up in body and soul to heavenly glory on completing her life on earth. **We may not always fully understand a dogma but we must believe in it; that is the gift of faith.**

The Confessions of Saint Augustine is considered one of the greatest Christian classics of all time. It is an extended poetic, passionate, intimate prayer that Augustine wrote as an autobiography sometime after his conversion, to confess his sins and proclaim God's goodness.

Just as his first hearers were captivated by his powerful conversion story, so also have many millions been over the following sixteen centuries. His experience of God speaks to us across time with little need of transpositions.
