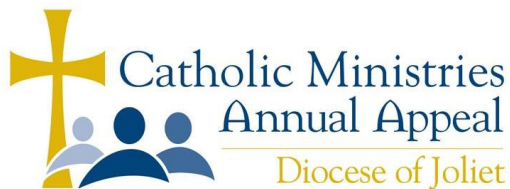

Find Victory in Those Palms to Ashes!

We will be collecting old palms through February 15. A basket will be placed in the Narthex for them. We will be burn the palms and the ashes will be used for Ash Wednesday Services on February 18.

Ashes, made by burning palms blessed the previous Palm Sunday, symbolize the transience of our earthly status. The body must fall temporarily into dust. This fact should serve as a challenge to spiritual accomplishments. Through grace we were “buried” in Christ that we may rise with him and “live unto God”. We explain ashes with the “seed” idea. “They are not a sign of death but a promise of life.” Ashes are a sign of Victory...the Victory we all experience in His Resurrection and is a sign of what is yet to come.

SHOP-SES
SHOP-SES IS FREE MONEY FOR OUR PARISH

SHOP-SES is a pre-paid card program in which the parish can purchase store gift cards at a discount. By selling the cards at face value, the parish can generate additional funds without costing the parishioners additional money. Cards are used as cash at the various stores. Last year SHOP-SES generated over **\$2,450** for the parish. Since SHOP-SES started in January 2011, the program has generated over **\$70,000** for the parish. This happened \$1.00 at a time by parishioners using the SHOP-SES program.

FINDING MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT

When a mental health issue arises it can be a confusing time to find the help you need. Here are a few steps to help you along the way:

- ♦ Not every therapist treats every disorder. Ensure the therapist has experience with the particular cause of the mental health issue.
- ♦ Find a therapist who specializes in the age group of the person receiving treatment.
- ♦ Check your insurance coverage and then ensure the therapist accepts your insurance coverage.
- ♦ Many employer sponsored programs provide a certain number of therapy visits without any money out of your pocket.
- ♦ Call the therapist and get an idea of the approach they use. For example, some only do group therapy, which is effective but is very different from individual therapy.
- ♦ Consider logistics. Assess travel times to ensure you can get to the weekly appointments. Many therapists are now using video conferencing for appointments, which is one of the positive outcomes of the COVID years.
- ♦ Find a Christian therapist. Yes, it does make a big difference. Start here and in addition to this website, there are many very good Christian therapists in the Naperville area: <https://catholictherapists.com/>
- ♦ Be open to changing therapists. Effective therapy comes when the patient and therapist have a solid personality comfort.
- ♦ If the individual needing help is a threat to themselves or others, immediately get professional help.

Handmaid of the Lord

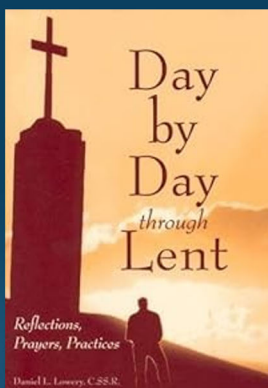
Mary's "YES" to the Father's plan is called her *fiat*. **This is the first Christian Prayer, and is the prayer of all Christians.** Mary shows us that to belong to Christ is to entrust ourselves totally to Him. Mary models for us the grace of faith—trusting God because we believe in who He is.

In this first Christian prayer; Mary calls herself the "handmaid" of the Lord. Mary is telling God that she is completely at His disposal, ready to do whatever He asks of her. Handmaid is translated servant. **Mary models for us the grace of total submission to the will of the Father.** To be God's servant we must be willing to do whatever He asks of us. We must respond, each and every day of our lives, to God with our "YES, be it done according to Your Word."

If Mary had not said yes to the Father, then Jesus would not have been born. **Because of this, Mary assumes a unique role in how God's grace comes into the world.** Mary is our intercessor because in a very special way she brings our prayers before her Son. At the foot of the cross, Jesus makes His mother, the Mother of the Church. As Mother of the Church, Mary is also our mother. We can never love Mary more than Jesus did.

Who is there better than our heavenly Mother to pray for us? Who better than Mary to have a special relationship with? Who knows Jesus better than His mother Mary? Mary leads all God's children to her Son and Savior. **Do you have a relationship with Mary? If not, 2026 is the year to draw close to her. She is simply waiting for your invitation to surround you with the love of God and carry all your requests to her Son.**

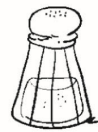

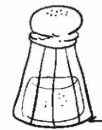
