But sometimes it is unavoidable.

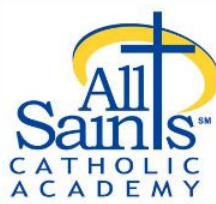

Forms of Prayer - In scripture, we find five forms of prayer: Blessing and Adoration, Petition, Intercession, Thanksgiving, and Praise. Let's reflect on these forms of prayer.

*We worship God through prayers of **blessing and adoration**. God first blesses us, then we send our prayers up to God, blessing Him, and asking for His blessing upon us. Adoration is the attitude of the human heart before God, acknowledging that God is our Creator and that we are His creature. **Only with a heart full of adoration can we truly receive God's blessings and respond with a blessing in return.**

***In prayers of petition** we ask God for good things, including our needs and our wants. When we petition God for the things we need, we acknowledge that we are God's creatures who have sinned and who are in need of His divine assistance. **This is the attitude of the heart that we must have whenever we pray.**

***The prayer of intercession** is also a prayer of asking. But instead of focusing on personal needs, it is concerned with the needs of others. **We become a bridge to God through our prayer for another person.**

***In prayers of thanksgiving**, we give thanks to God for every gift He has given us. We give thanks to God for hearing and answering our prayers, even as we request them because we have faith. Sometimes it is hard to understand how God answers our prayers. Especially in difficult circumstances we can be tempted to think that God doesn't hear us or love us. **We must trust in God's loving plan for each one of us as He answers our prayers.**

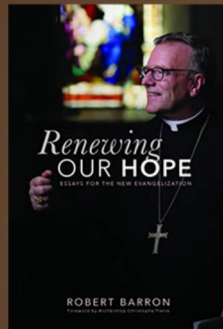
***Praise is the form of prayer** by which we celebrate God's goodness. We glorify God simply because **HE IS**. **This prayer should be continually in our hearts and on our lips.**

The Eucharist expresses all forms of prayer. It is a pure offering of thanksgiving and adoration that glorify God. It is a sacrifice of praise that satisfies all our needs. There's no better way of offering our hearts to God than by inviting Jesus into our hearts in the Blessed Sacrament!

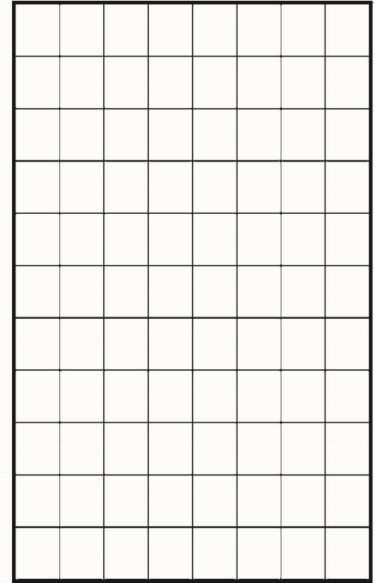
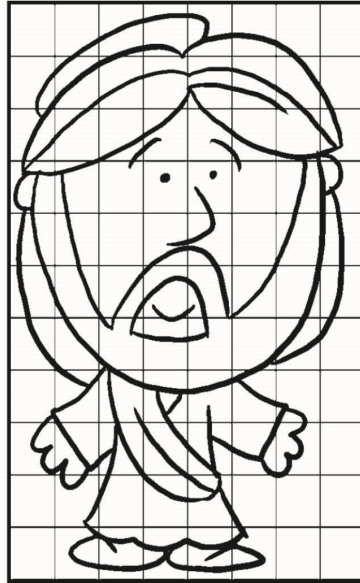

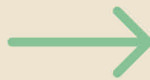
