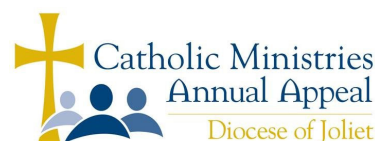

Dear Parishioners,

Our parish is blessed with facilities that serve our worship, ministries, and community gatherings. Maintaining these buildings and grounds requires ongoing care and, at times, significant investment.

Over the past year, several important capital improvements have already been completed or are underway. These include repairs to the parish roof and elevator, along with new windows for the rectory and replacement of several exterior doors to improve safety, energy efficiency, and the overall upkeep of our parish buildings. In addition, we are closely monitoring the condition of our boiler system, which may soon require significant repair or replacement.

We have also experienced higher-than-expected snow removal costs this winter due to the increased snowfall, which has placed additional pressure on the parish budget.

Parking Lot and Capital Needs

One of the most pressing needs facing our parish is major repair work to the parking lot, along with other infrastructure improvements. The estimated cost for these capital projects is approximately **\$400,000**. To ensure we take the most responsible and informed approach, we are in the process of hiring a civil engineer to conduct a thorough assessment and provide expert guidance on the scope of work required.

A Generous Matching Opportunity

We are grateful that several parishioners have stepped forward with a generous offer. They are willing to match donations dollar-for-dollar up to \$50,000 if our parish community can raise that same amount within the next 60 days. This means that if we reach the \$50,000 goal, \$100,000 will go toward these necessary improvements.

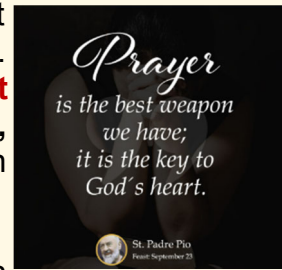

Prayer is a gift that requires a response. However, our response is not always easy. There are many obstacles we encounter in the life of prayer. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, **“prayer is a battle.”** **Against whom? Against ourselves and against the tempter,** Satan, who does all he can to turn us away from prayer, away from union with God.



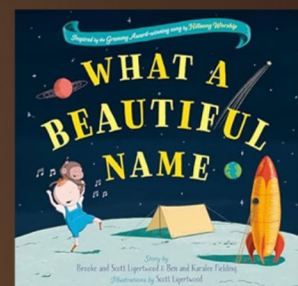
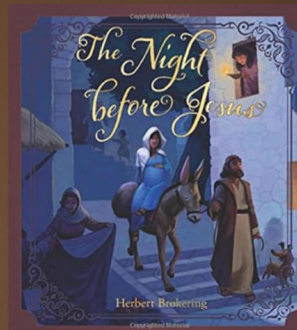
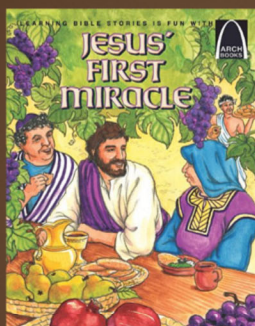
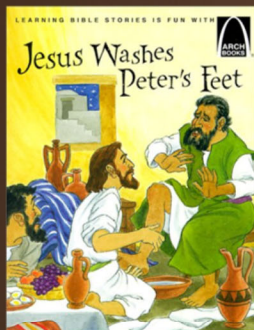
We pray as we live because we live as we pray. The battle against prayer is against our own weaknesses, temptations, failures, distractions and laziness. It also is against the work of the devil himself. **To be successful in this battle we must humbly recognize that we cannot do it alone.** We must trust in God to hear our prayer and we must persevere against all obstacles.

Distraction is the most difficult and common obstacle to prayer especially in our electronically dominated and immediate response culture. Our minds are challenged to remain focused on a single activity. To combat this obstacle: we can still our mind and invite the Holy Spirit's assistance as we begin prayer; find a quiet space without our phone; choose a prayer posture that helps us connect with God (eyes closed, sit, kneel) and open our heart to God.

Dryness, another hurdle, is when we feel that God is not listening. Our relationship with God should not be based on our feelings. It's about giving God the worship that He deserves and trusting He is always with us as a loving Father.

Our lack of faith is also an barrier in the battle of prayer. Do I only pray to God as a last resort? Do I expect God to answer my prayers the way I want Him to? Only when we are in constant communication with God, praying according to His Divine Will, we will experience His tremendous love and care for us. Then we overcome the obstacles and find **VICTORY in PRAYER!**

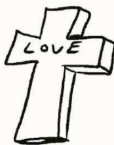
