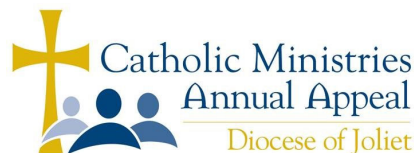

## Sacramentals

The Church provides us with sacramentals to aid us in prayer and to give us particular graces.

**A sacramental is a prayer, practice, or object that helps us receive the grace of God.**

Sacramentals include the rosary, the Sign of the Cross, holy water, crucifixes, icons, scapulars, blessings and other items that remind us of God's love.

**A sacramental object does not have the power of a Sacrament.**

However, sacramentals are signs or physical reminders of a spiritual reality, and they prepare us to receive the grace of the Sacraments and make everyday life holy. For example, we ask God's blessing for safe travels before a trip or offer a blessing over a meal before eating. Praying a family rosary helps strengthen our spiritual lives united as a family. A medal or scapular, worn around the neck, promises particular graces and serve as a constant reminder to live holy lives and pray to God more often.



**Sacramentals should not be thought of as contracts, investments, or good luck charms.**

To wear the scapular does not give us free reign to commit mortal sin and still be assured of heaven. The scapular is a devotion and silent prayer to Our Blessed Mother. Holy water is not the infallible wiping away of our venial sins unless we have contrition for our sins when we use it. **The Church, through Christ's passion, death and resurrection, has given us these sacred signs to lead us in holiness, and to better recognize an authentic Christian life.**

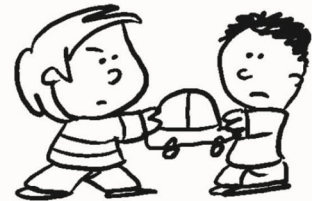
