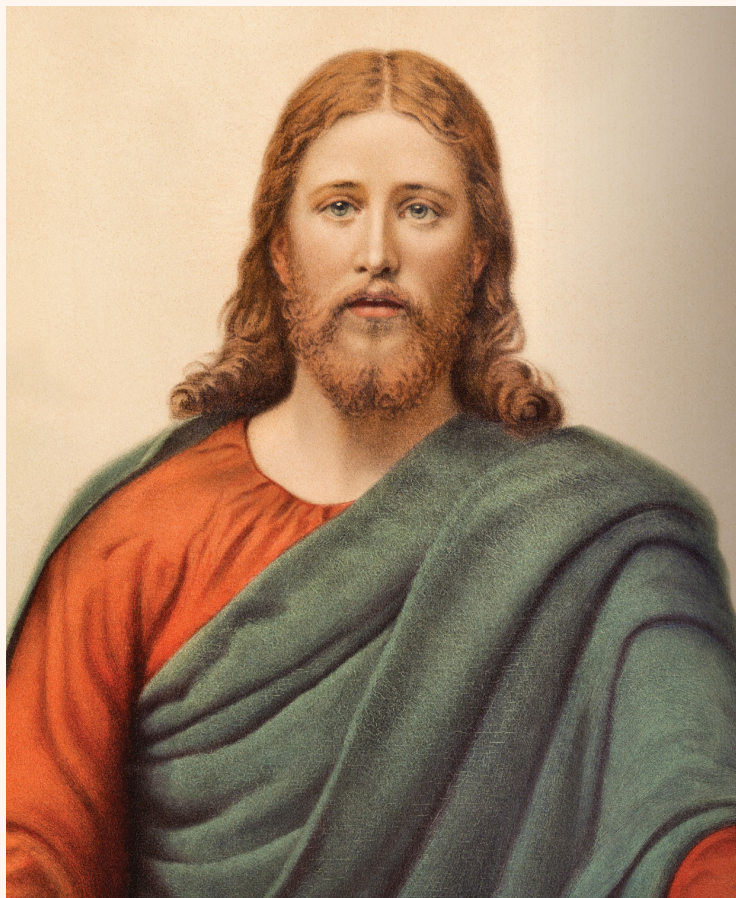

A Note from Father Tony Taschetta

Beloved and holy people of Saint Elizabeth Seton,

So how do I do this? Or more accurately, how do “we” do this? How do we celebrate and say “thank you” to one who has touched our lives on so many deep levels and given us so much for the past 25 years?

On June 2, 2001, at the hands of Bishop Joseph Imesch, young Scott Huggins, by the laying on of hands, was made a priest... Forever! He was set aside on behalf of the people of God, that he may lead them into the heart of God. And for the past 25 years, he has done just that.

Deacon Emmanuel Eklou Update

A number of parishioners have asked about Deacon Emmanuel and why he has not been around the parish over the past few months. I wanted to provide a brief update and clarification.

Several months ago, St. Mary Nativity Parish in Joliet requested assistance from the Diocese in the form of a deacon assignment. Shortly thereafter, Deacon Emmanuel received a letter from the Diocese assigning him to St. Mary Nativity for a temporary period of service extending through September 2027. I was copied on the assignment letter, but at the time there was some initial confusion regarding the details and timing of the assignment, especially since the priest at St. Mary Nativity was out of town and Deacon Emmanuel was unable to speak with him immediately.

I believe I briefly mentioned the situation at a few Masses with the intention of sending a formal update to the parish once everything was clarified. Unfortunately, as the weeks passed and the details were settled, I neglected to send out an official explanation.

At present, Deacon Emmanuel is faithfully serving at St. Mary Nativity under this diocesan assignment from the Bishop. While he remains a deacon of our parish family and is free to assist at St. Elizabeth Seton when his schedule permits, we likely will not see much of him here until his current assignment concludes.

Please keep Deacon Emmanuel and the parishioners of St. Mary Nativity in your prayers as he continues his ministry there.
