A Note from Father Tony Taschetta

Beloved and holy people of Saint Elizabeth Seton,

So how do I do this? Or more accurately, how do “we” do this? How do we celebrate and say “thank you” to one who has touched our lives on so many deep levels and given us so much for the past 25 years?

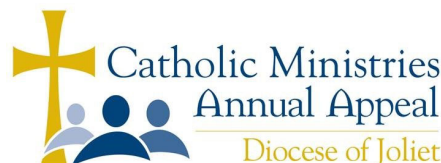

POLICY ON MASS INTENTIONS:

Church Law, Canon 948 states that “*separate Masses are to be applied for the intentions for which an individual offering has been made and accepted. The priest who accepts such offerings is bound in justice to satisfy the obligations personally or by committing them to another* (Cc. 989, 954-55).” In 1991, the Congregations of the Clergy issued a decree in which permission was given to accept several offerings for a collective intention at a single Mass.

The following regulations must be observed:

- 1) The donors must be informed of and consent to the combining of their offerings before the Mass at which the collective intention is.
- 2) The time and place for the Mass must be announced.
- 3) The practice may not be observed more than twice a week.

These collective intentions will be held at St. Elizabeth Seton on Fridays at 8:15am and Saturdays at 5:00pm during the year, provided the day does not fall on a Church Feast or Holiday, such as Christmas. **No more than three intentions can be celebrated at each of these two Masses.** These intentions will be scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. All other Masses will be offered for a single intention only, in accordance with Church Law.

Please note: A family may schedule a maximum of five intentions for any one individual per year.

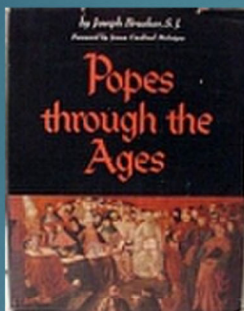

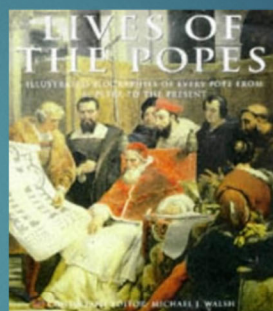

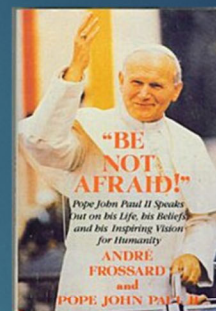

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

"He breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.'" (John 20:22-23)

For those of us who go to confession regularly, there is often a familiar frustration: "Why do I keep confessing the same sins?" It can feel like a loop, cleansed but unchanged.

Pentecost reveals a hopeful perspective. When the Risen Jesus breathes on his ashamed and fearful disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit, he echoes Genesis, when God breathes life into Adam. This is not just primarily the removal of guilt, but new creation.

In confession, we receive more than forgiveness. We receive a fresh outpouring, the breath of the Spirit, and a renewed mission. Jesus does not say to us, "You're forgiven, now go back to your old life." He says, so to speak, **"As the Father has sent me, so I send you."** (John 20:21)

That is why penance is not just saying a few prayers. It is reorientation. It is the Spirit summoning us to live differently: with mercy and healing.

Just as Adam was sent into the world, and the Apostles were sent out after Pentecost, so too we are sent from the confessional — not just clean, but consecrated.

Pentecost Challenge: After your next confession, ask the Holy Spirit for one way you can participate in Christ's healing will for you. Then take one small, concrete step, and do not look back.

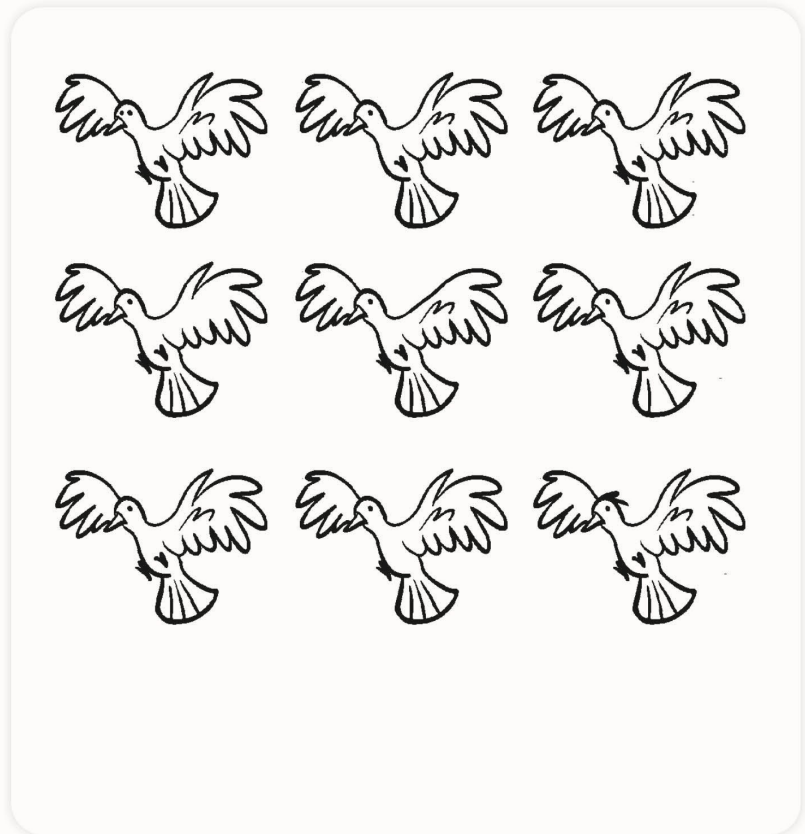
Sharing the Gospel
