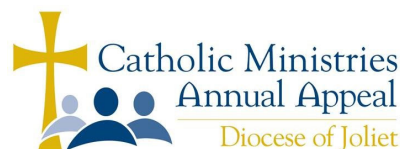

- An EOM assists with the distribution of the Eucharist at Mass and may take Eucharist to the sick or homebound.

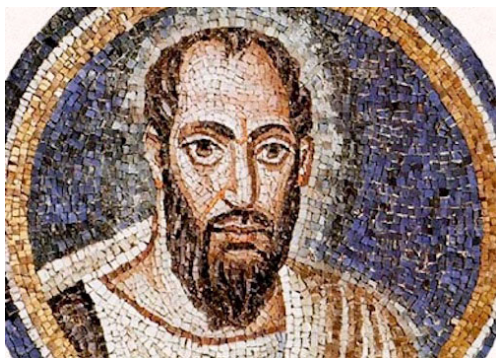

***Today we celebrate
The Most Holy Trinity***

Trinity is the state of being three, as one God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The mystery of the most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of our faith, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. Three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature, is difficult for our mind to grasp.

Today's feast invites us to live in the awareness of the presence of The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. To believe as our Blessed Virgin Mary did:

1. *We must be contemplative about the work of God the Father (creation).*
2. *We must allow Christ, the Son, to dwell within us (redemption).*
3. *We must surrender to the work of the Holy Spirit (inspiration within).*

JUBILEE YEAR 2025 JUNE CELEBRATIONS



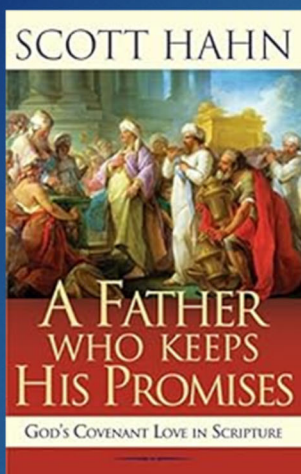
