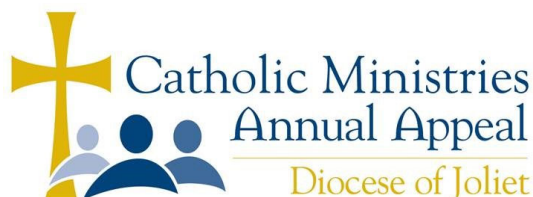

## Creation Care Corner

### Electric Vehicles: A Creation Care Benefit ?

Transportation emissions in the United States are a large source of both air pollution and climate-warming greenhouse gas emissions (GHGs). The Iran war's oil price shock, which has pushed the US national average above \$4 per gallon has reignited consumer interest in EVs. But are there creation care and economic benefits to making the switch?

When comparing EVs to gas powered vehicles, EVs typically are a creation care benefit. According to the US Dept. of Energy, electric vehicles today produce 46% fewer GHGs than comparable gasoline powered vehicles on a life cycle basis. Whether it is an economic benefit depends on numerous factors, including whether you have a garage to charge the vehicle, the current price of gas, the number of miles you drive, and state electricity rates. The equivalent “cost per gallon” for average EV charging costs is less than \$1.65 per gallon for most states. A vibrant EV used car market could accelerate the payback calculation. Don’t forget other emission reducing alternatives like reducing # of vehicles/family, driving less, and using public transportation. For more information: <https://tinyurl.com/CCCEVinfo>

Your love, your sacrifices, and your perseverance matter. God can use even your wounds to strengthen others.

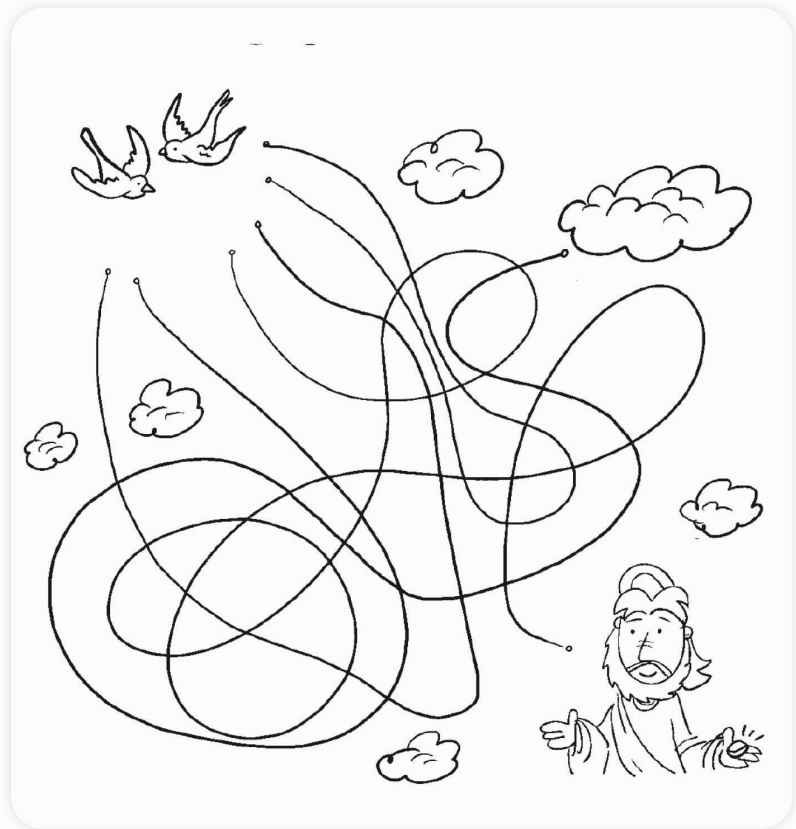
## Sharing the Gospel
