SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: A couple planning on being married at St. Elizabeth Seton should contact the church six months in advance. One year is preferred. Either the bride or groom, or their parents, must be a registered parishioner for at least three months prior to calling to set a date.

Message from Fr. Scott

Supporting Catholic Education at All Saints Catholic Academy

For many years, St. Elizabeth Seton Parish has been a proud sponsoring parish of All Saints Catholic Academy. From the beginning, our parish joined with the other sponsoring parishes to help establish a strong Catholic school in Naperville that would provide an academically excellent and faith-filled education for future generations of children and families.

When the school was originally formed, parishioners were informed that the sponsoring parishes would assist in the effort to establish and launch the school, with the long-term expectation that the school would eventually become financially self-sustaining. At the same time, the understanding was that parishes would continue supporting Catholic education primarily through tuition assistance for parish families demonstrating financial need.

Recently, after discussions among the Diocese and the sponsoring parishes, a new financial support model was adopted for All Saints Catholic Academy. Under this arrangement, the sponsoring parishes will now provide annual operational support directly to the school in addition to continuing tuition assistance for parish families in need.

As many parishioners know, I expressed concerns regarding this change and the long-term financial obligations it places upon the parish. I also recognize that some members of our parish community may share similar concerns, particularly in light of the expectations originally communicated when the parish agreed to participate in the creation of All Saints. As we move forward, the Diocese has determined this model, and as a parish we will work to fulfill these obligations responsibly, transparently, and in a way that continues to support the important mission of Catholic education.

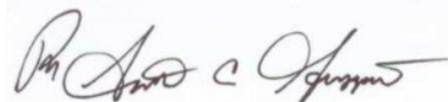
For the next three years, St. Elizabeth Seton Parish will contribute:

- **\$42,854 annually** toward the school's operating fund
- Approximately **\$17,000 annually** in direct tuition assistance for parish families

This means the parish will be contributing nearly **\$60,000 annually** in support of Catholic education through All Saints Catholic Academy.

To help meet these obligations in a responsible and transparent manner, St. Elizabeth Seton Parish will begin taking up a **special monthly collection dedicated to All Saints Catholic Academy**. All funds collected through this effort will be placed into a **restricted account** and used solely to offset the parish's financial responsibilities related to All Saints.

We recognize that this effort will require the support of our parish community, and we are grateful for your continued generosity and prayers as we continue supporting both our parish and the mission of Catholic education.

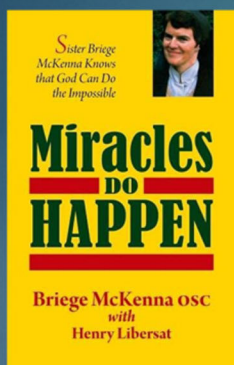

Our VBS theme is True North this summer.

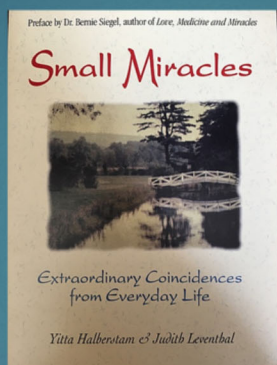

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Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

This weekend, our nation celebrates the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Unlike most nations, the United States was not founded primarily on a shared ethnicity, language, or culture. Instead, our founders built a political community out of diverse peoples united by a shared vision of liberty. That vision echoes something deep in the Christian mystery revealed in today's Gospel.

Jesus returns to his hometown. The people see only what is familiar: the carpenter, the son of Mary, one of their own. As Mark tells us, **“They took offense at him. Jesus said, ‘A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.’”** Their narrow vision blinds them. Jesus has come to inaugurate a new communion that transcends geography, bloodlines, and culture. He has come to unite all people in himself.

At its best, America's national unity reflects this possibility, which fully subsists only in the Catholic Church. Our unity is not based on ancestry or tribe, but on a shared commitment to higher ideals. For this reason, we can love our country with gratitude while situating patriotism within the broader horizon of faith.

Rooted in Christ, we are less vulnerable to the unholy tribalism that threatens civic life and faith. This weekend, let us thank God for our nation and pray that we also live as citizens of Heaven in Jesus Christ.

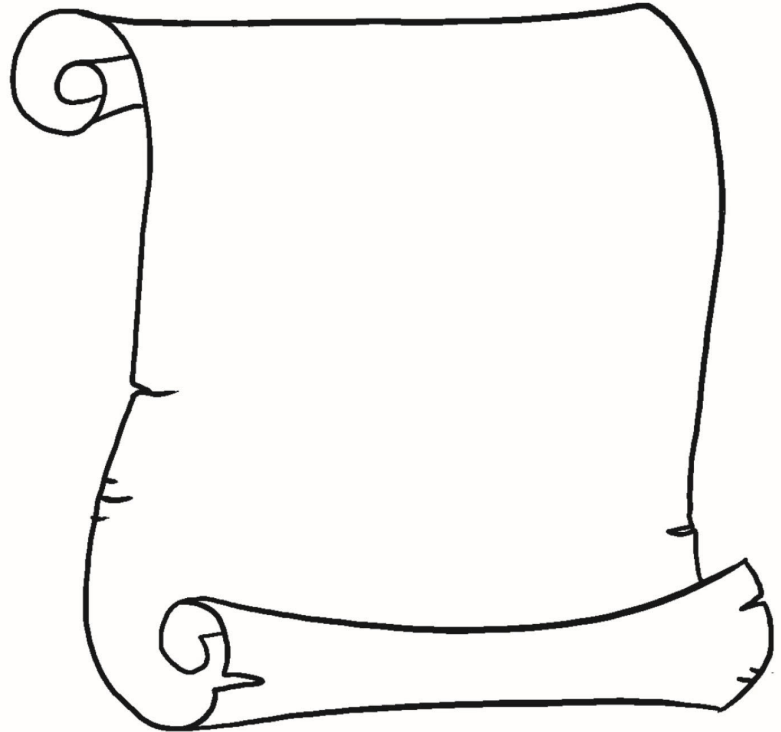
