Did you know?

You can reduce your Federal Income Tax bill by making a charitable contribution to St. Elizabeth Seton from your IRA via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD).

A few things:

1. You must be over age 70½ at the time of the distribution.
2. You are NOT required to itemize your deductions to obtain the tax benefit.
3. QCD can count towards your annual Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

The rules for QCD's are very complex, and you should consult with your tax advisor as soon as possible in order to maximize your tax benefit.

Our Family Faith Formation program is looking for **Loving Leaders** to serve once a month for an hour sharing the love of Jesus with the children in Family Faith Formation.



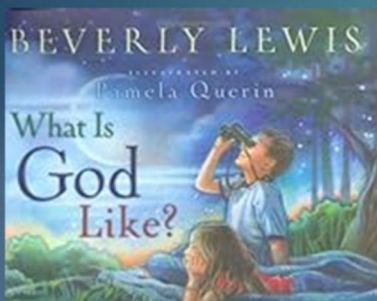

A detailed lesson is provided.

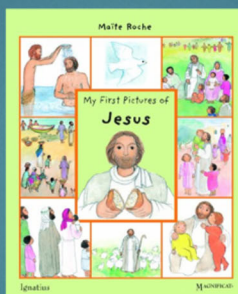
