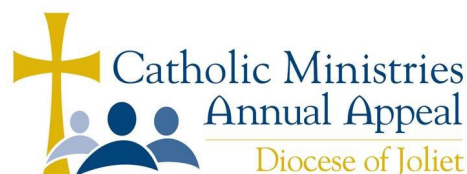

Why are We Ringing the Bells Three Times Instead of Twice at Mass?

The Altar Server now rings the bells during the **Epiclesis**. The Epiclesis is the prayer in which the priest, speaking in the person of Jesus Christ, calls upon the Father to send down his Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This change occurs through the institution narrative ("This is my Body/Blood..."), by the power of the words of Christ pronounced by the priest. **The bells alert us (3 times) to a central mystery of our Catholic faith.**

SES High School Youth Ministry

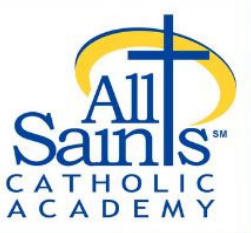
- ♦ In May, the high schoolers packed over 20 boxes for soldiers through Operation Shoebox - these items will be sent to military personnel currently deployed.

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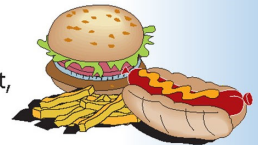

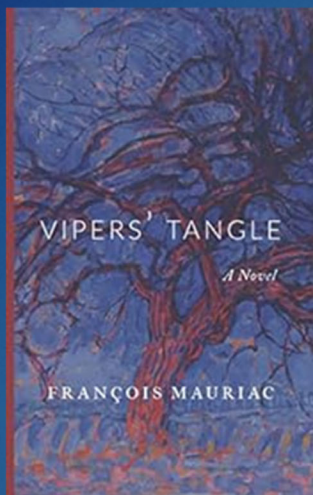

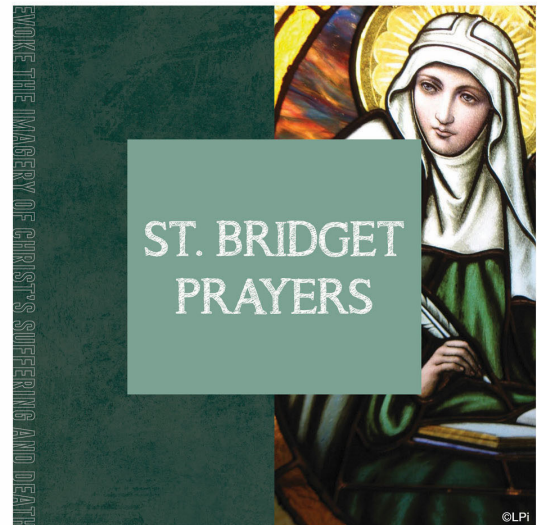
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Live The Liturgy Inspiration of the Week
