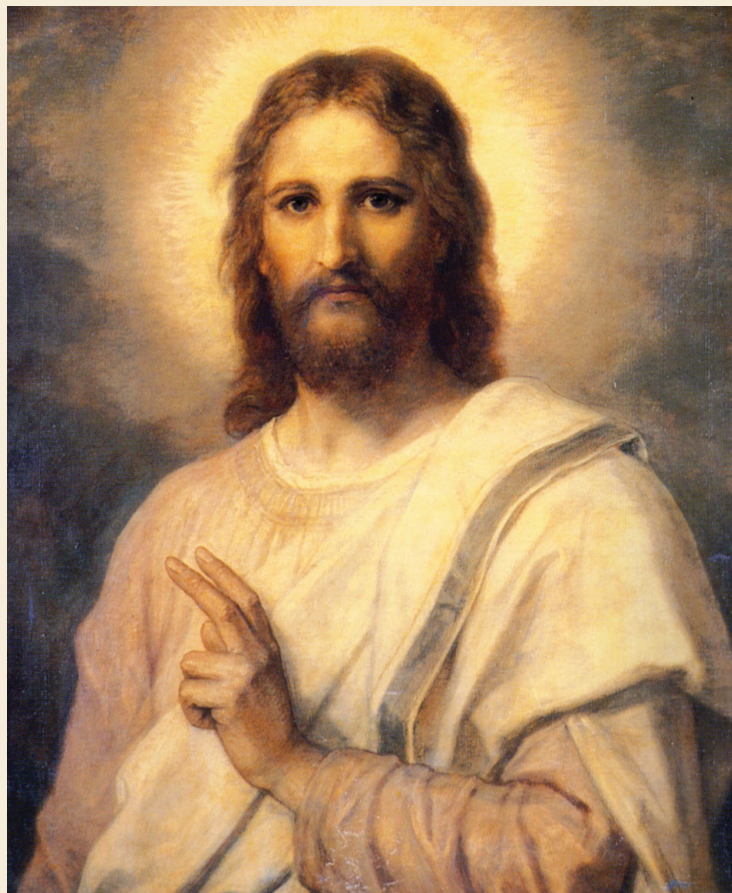

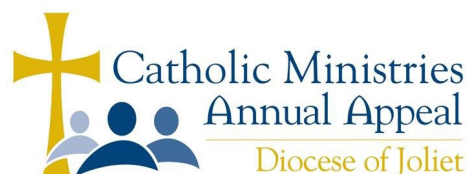

The Parish Office will be open Monday-Thursday from 8:00am to 4:00pm.

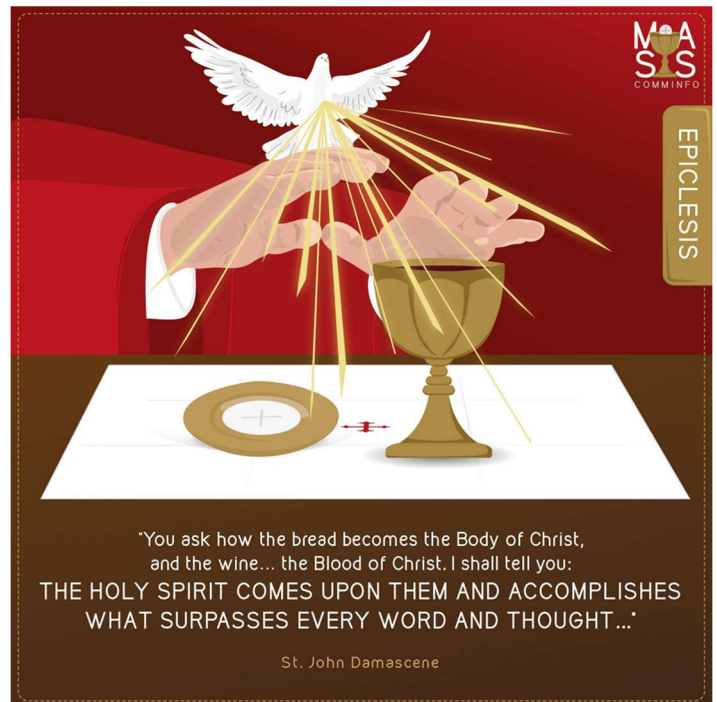

Why are We Ringing the Bells Three Times Instead of Twice at Mass?

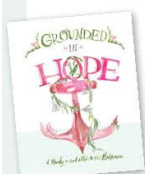
The Altar Server now rings the bells during the **Epicicles**. The Epicicles is the prayer in which the priest, speaking in the person of Jesus Christ, calls upon the Father to send down his Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This change occurs through the institution narrative ("This is my Body/Blood..."), by the power of the words of Christ pronounced by the priest. **The bells alert us (3 times) to a central mystery of our Catholic faith.**
