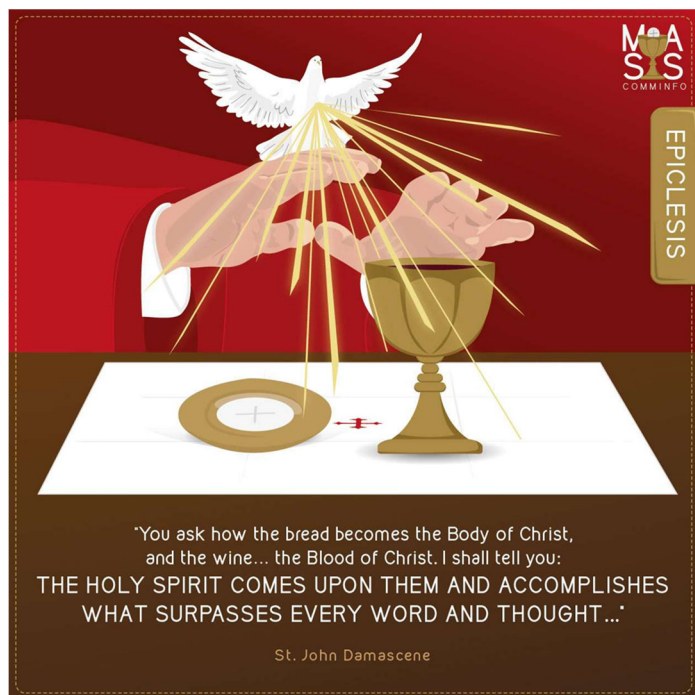

Why are We Ringing the Bells Three Times Instead of Twice at Mass?

The Altar Server now rings the bells during the **Epiclesis**. The Epiclesis is the prayer in which the priest, speaking in the person of Jesus Christ, calls upon the Father to send down his Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This change occurs through the institution narrative ("This is my Body/Blood..."), by the power of the words of Christ pronounced by the priest. **The bells alert us (3 times) to a central mystery of our Catholic faith.**

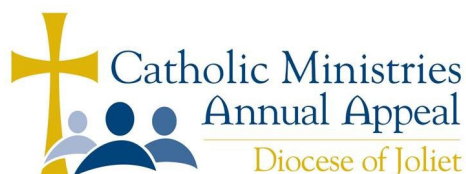

Ertha Papillon to Visit St. Elizabeth Seton

August 16/17

Ertha is from the village of Duchity in the mountains of southwest Haiti. After being educated by Catholic Sisters, she traveled to Port-au-Prince where she became a nurse. She worked with and was influenced by Mother Theresa. She felt a calling to return to Duchity and serve the poorest children in Trois-Bois, in the countryside outside the village. She founded and directs a school and an orphanage in this area.



Life is difficult in Haiti today. Gangs control the roads. Produce and other goods coming from Port-au-Prince are limited, resulting in higher prices. Peanut butter, once a staple, is no longer available. Many of the families are struggling to survive. The orphanage and school share those struggles.

Ertha, an approved lay missionary speaker will provide her reflection at all Masses the weekend of August 16th and 17th. There will also be a separate second collection to benefit Ertha's efforts this weekend.

The Diocese of Joliet welcomes and includes people of all abilities.

The disABILITIES Ministry provides sacramental preparation, faith formation, special events and liturgical celebrations. The Deaf Ministry provides the same for Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing individuals by utilizing American Sign Language (ASL).

If you know of anyone in financial, mental, physical or spiritual crisis, please consider requesting a prayer quilt for them.

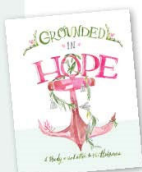

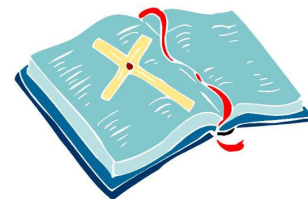

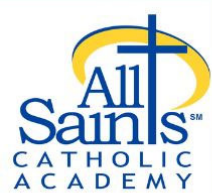
SHOP-SES START PLANNING FOR BACK TO SCHOOL
