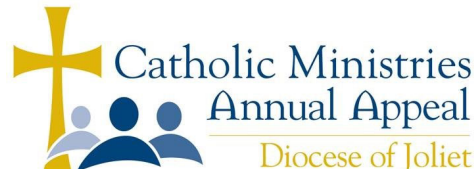

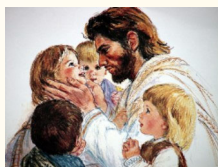

During the school year at the 10 a.m. Mass, children in kindergarten through second grade are invited to participate in **Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)** - a special time just for them to hear and reflect on the Sunday Gospel in ways they can understand.



After the Opening Prayer, children joyfully head downstairs to their own sacred space, **where trained leaders break open the scripture readings and share an age-appropriate reflection on the Gospel.** They return to their families during the Offertory to continue celebrating the Eucharist together.

We provide training, resources, and ongoing support—no teaching background is needed, just a joyful spirit and a desire to help little ones fall in love with Jesus. 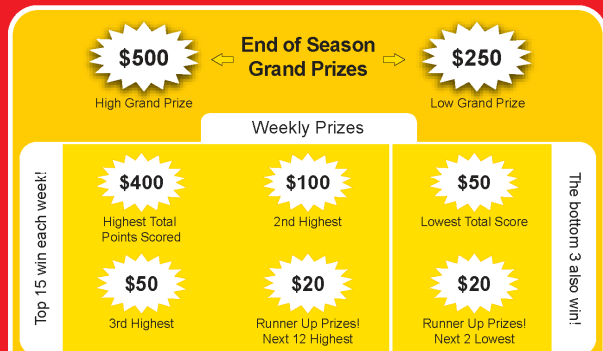
