Dear Parishioners,

At St. Elizabeth Seton, we are abundantly blessed with a vibrant faith community. Together, we serve in more than **60 ministries and outreach programs**, touching countless lives through prayer, service, and generosity.

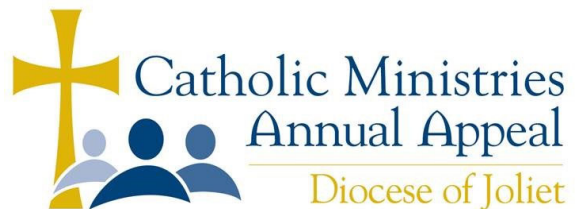

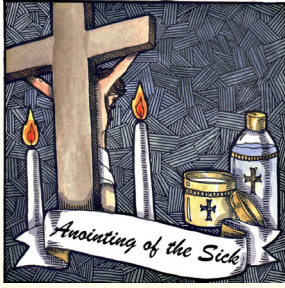
**On Sunday, October 5th at 1:00 P.M., we will

Our Guardian Angel

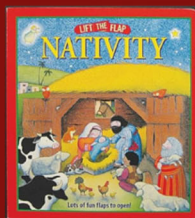
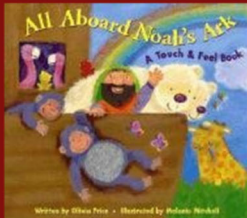
"See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of My heavenly Father" (Matthew 18:10). Jesus shows His deep love for every person as He speaks these words immediately before He teaches the Parable of the Lost Sheep. God gives us our own guardian angel, who always looks upon the face of God, and whose sole task is to care for us and to get us to Heaven. **On October 2 we celebrate the Feast of the Guardian Angels.**

Our knowledge of guardian angels is deeply rooted in Scripture, in the writings of the saints and the teachings of the Church. With their hands they shall support you, lest you strike your foot against a stone" (Psalm 91:11–12). Angels are not only intercessors, but they are also mediators. Though God is fully capable of distributing His grace Himself, it is His will to share this grace through His angels.

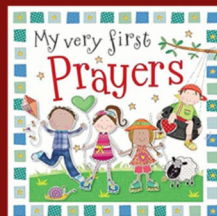
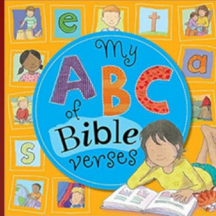
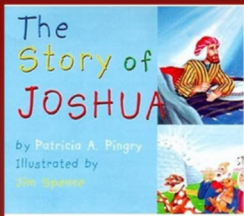
As we honor the celestial hosts of the Guardian Angels, ponder your own angel today and pray:

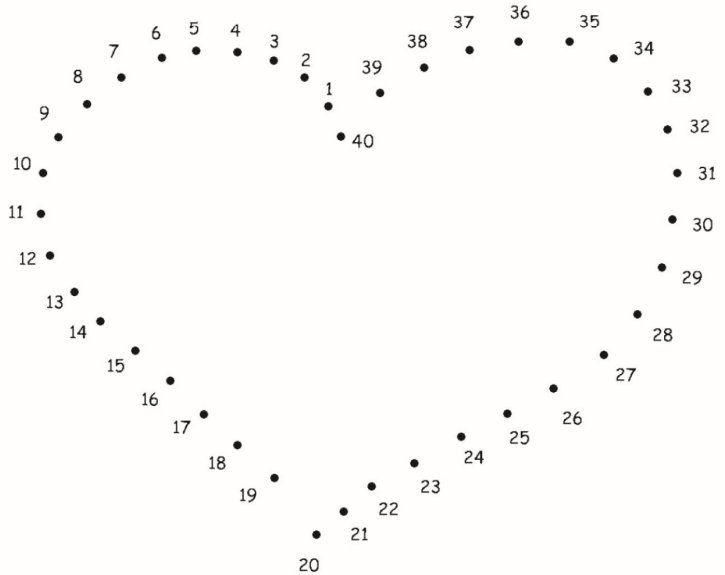
