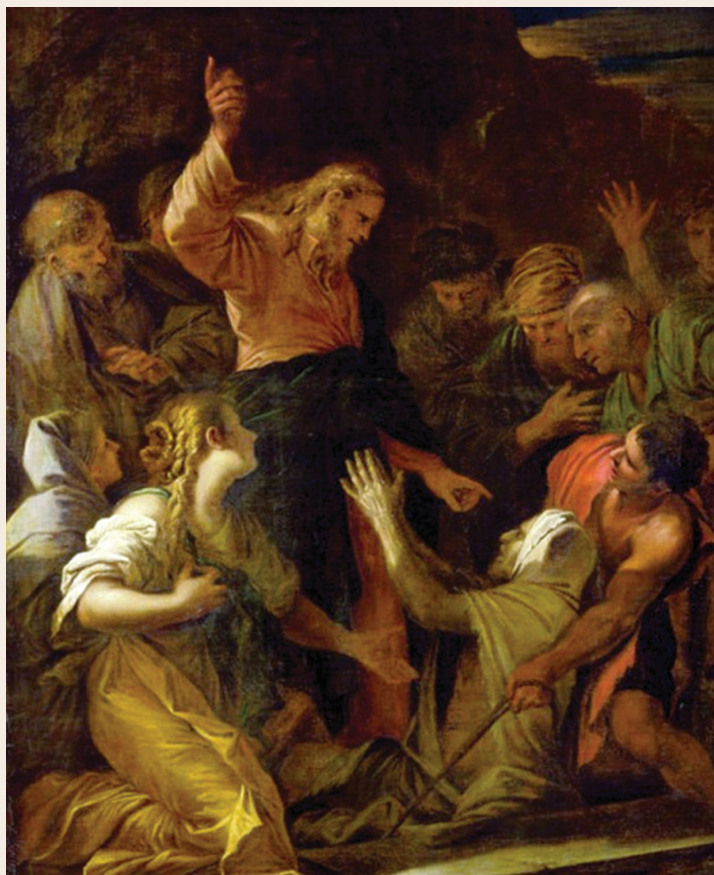

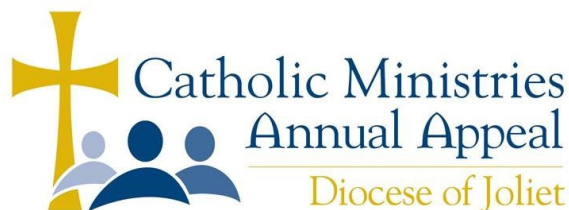

ALL SOULS NOVENA OF MASSES

November is the month in which we traditionally remember all of those who have died, our family and friends who have gone before us. We especially remember them on the Feast of All Souls on November 2.

This year we will be celebrating a Novena of Masses (9 in all) for all of your Beloved Deceased Family and Friends. All Souls Day envelopes were included in your envelope packet and will also be available at the Welcome Desk. Please take a few minutes to list the names of everyone you would like remembered, and place it in the collection basket. Those envelopes will be placed on the Altar for each of the Nine Masses of our Novena.

Whether or not you choose to include a stipend in the envelope is your choice, it is not required. But we do want to include all the names in the Mass intentions. The dates for the Novena Masses will be found in the Bulletin, starting on November 2, the Feast of All Souls.

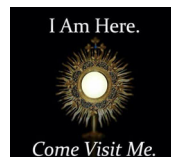

Tell me...what is Prayer?

Prayer is a conversation with God. He comes near to us, draws us into speaking with Him in order to give us life. **In the process, we are transformed.**

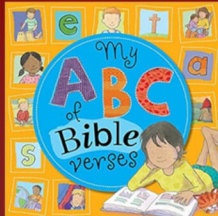
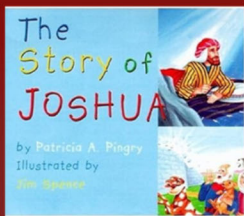
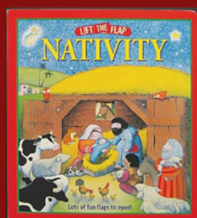
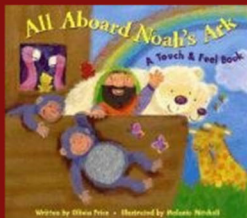


The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines prayer as

“Prayer is the raising of one’s mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God” (CCC 2559). When I pray, I should ask myself: Do I raise a proud or a humble heart to God? Do I demand that God does what I ask or do I pray that God opens my heart to His will? The Catechism says, **“Humility is the foundation of prayer”** (CCC 2559). Only with a humble heart can I open myself to the gift of prayer.

Prayer is a gift from God because it comes to me as a grace from God, it is not something that I can do with my own power. **“In prayer, the faithful God’s initiative of love always comes first; my own first step is always a response”** (CCC 2567). God seeks me out. God thirsts for me so that I may thirst for Him. This reminds us of Jesus’ thirst on the Cross. He thirsted my soul to turn to Him for salvation.

The heart is my innermost being, the place where I am made in the image and likeness of God. It is where I know, I love and I choose. The word ‘soul’ also describes this hidden center of my being. **Prayer is when my heart is united to the heart of God.** It is an intimate relationship with God.
