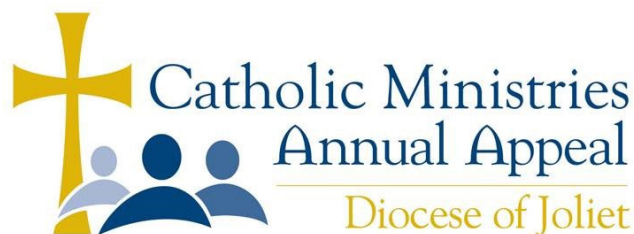

EATING DISORDERS LEAD TO INCREDIBLY DANGEROUS OUTCOMES!

- Prevalence has doubled over the last two decades!
- In 95% of those cases, the disorder begins by age 25

Types of eating disorders include:

- ✓ **Anorexia Nervosa** – intense fear of weight gain
- ✓ **Bulimia Nervosa** – primarily a cycle of binge eating followed by forced purging
- ✓ **Binge Eating Disorder** – binge eating without purging
- ✓ **Avoidant Restrictive Food Intake Disorder** – limitations in the amount and/or types of food...and others

Symptoms someone may be exhibiting include:

- ⇒ Consistent inadequate food intake and weight loss
- ⇒ Disturbance in self image, and overly concerned about how they are perceived
- ⇒ Purging and/or use of laxatives
- ⇒ Hiding food, consistently forgetting to take lunch to school, making excuses for missing meals
- ⇒ Binge eating followed by an immediate visit to the bathroom

In the overwhelmingly majority of cases, eating disorders require professional help! They do not get better on their own.

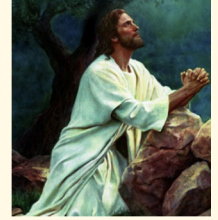

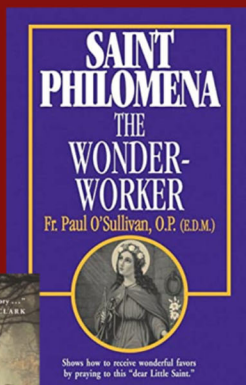
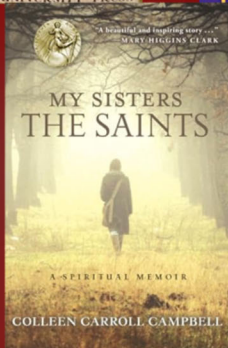
Jesus Shows Us to Pray

Jesus went to His Father for strength and direction in all the key moments of His life. **How did Jesus pray?** He always begins with thanksgiving and a statement that His Father in Heaven hears His prayer. **Jesus teaches us that God always hears our prayers, and that we should thank God before our prayer is answered.** Our love for God and our trust in God is a greater treasure than the answered prayer.



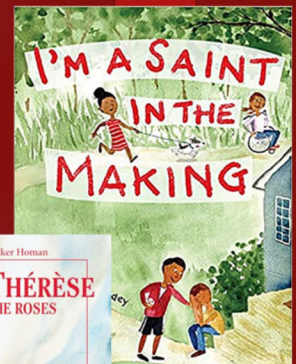
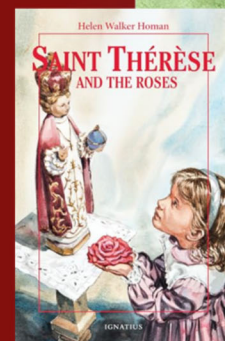
Jesus passed on to us 3 keys to prayer:

- 1) **Conversion** means a change. The key to a life of prayer is to experience a change in our heart, mind and actions. This change happens because we receive God's grace and love as we communicate with Him. Only when we humbly turn toward God and let Him fill our heart with His love do we experience conversion and enter into a special friendship with God.
- 2) **Once we have a conversion of heart, we must learn to pray in Faith.** With faith in God we can hope for and believe in all things God has revealed to us, even when we cannot see or understand them. True faith is trusting in God's will and plan for my life. This is how we are to pray...God may Your will be done.
- 3) **As God's children we are to be Watchful and ready** for the time when Jesus will come again. We must live every moment of our lives as if God is coming **TODAY** in glory, to judge the living and the dead. We pray to be ready and to live the holy life that God has called us to live.

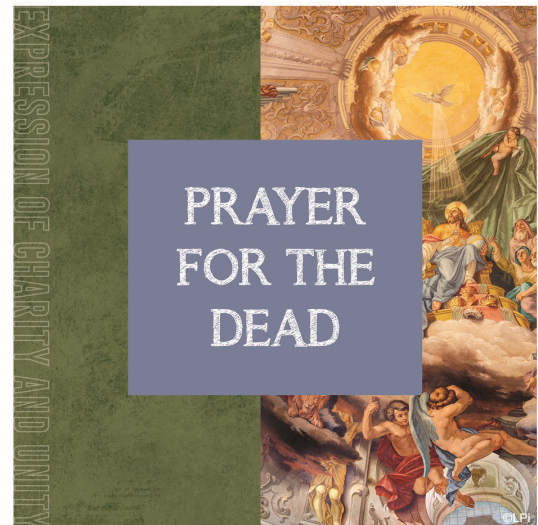

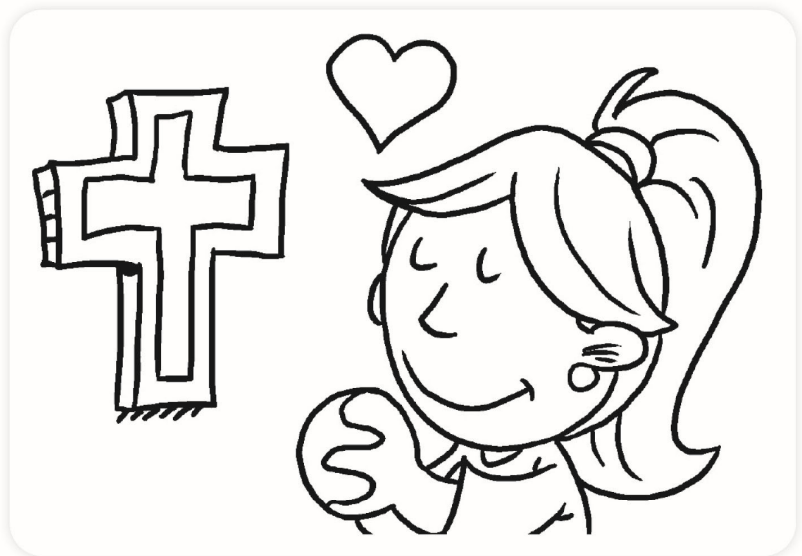
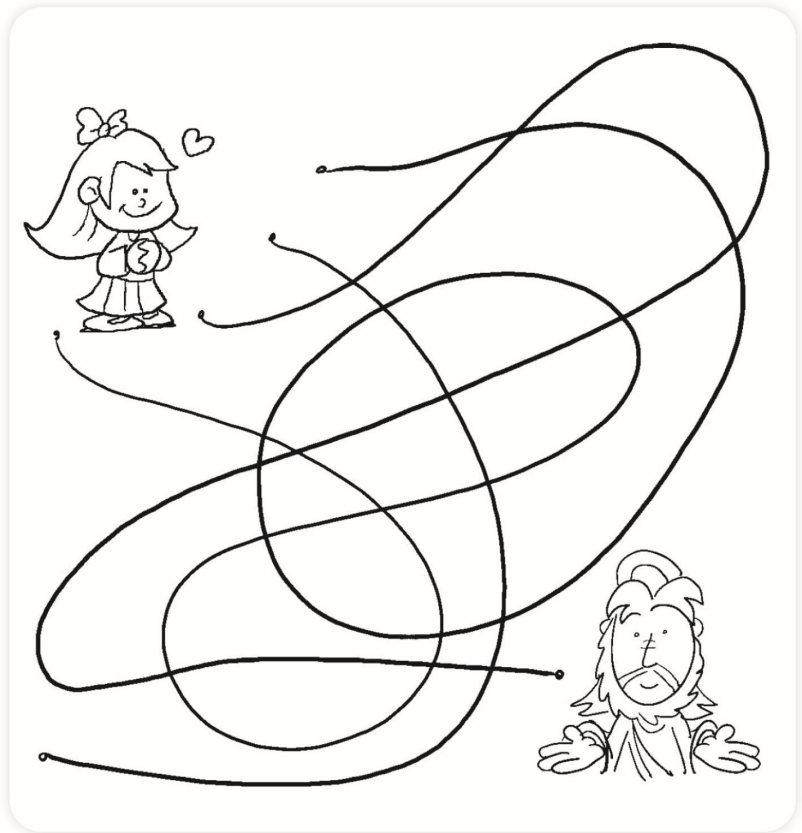
