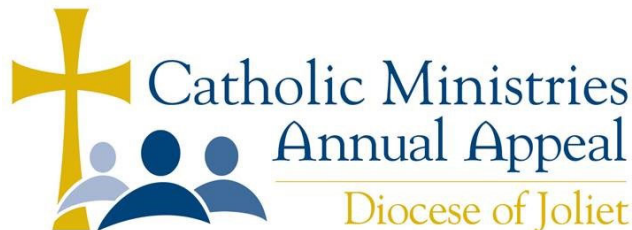

Summary of the Whole Gospel



Jesus gave us the Our Father, also known as the Lord's Prayer. The Catechism says, **"The Lord's Prayer is 'truly the summary of the whole gospel.'** Jesus gave us the Our Father to teach us to know what we need in order to live as sons and daughters of God. The prayer shares with us the "Good News" that we are children of God, which is the message of the Gospel.

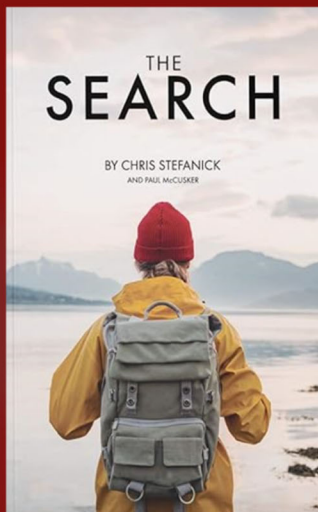
Perhaps the most striking and radical revelation in this prayer, is that Jesus calls God His Father and asks us to do the same. The Catechism explains, "Jesus not only gives us the words of our filial prayer; at the same time He gives us the Spirit by whom these words become in us 'spirit and life'. **This Spirit, sent into our hearts by God the Father, cries out "Abba, Father!"** (Galatians 4:6). The term "Abba" reveals intimacy, God invites us to enter into a familial relationship with Him.

When we pray "Father," we acknowledge that we are God's adopted sons and daughters. Through the grace of Baptism we have been reborn into life in Christ. This grace is a free gift given to us because of God's great love for us and His desire that we spend eternity with Him in Heaven.

Recognizing our dignity as a child of God should cause us to "desire to become like Him."

St. Cyprian said, *"We must remember when we call God 'our Father' we ought to behave as sons and daughters of God."* (CCC 2784) **What a blessed and high calling we have been given!**

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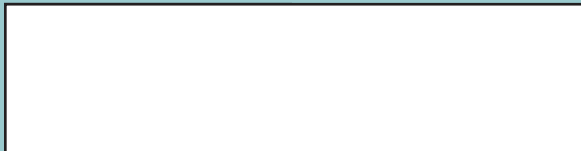
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
