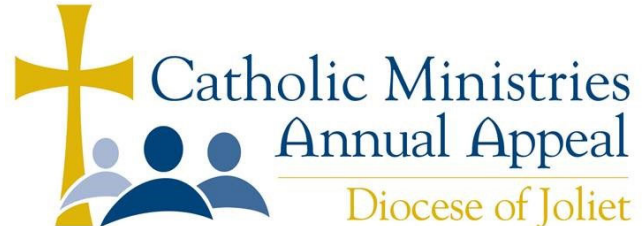

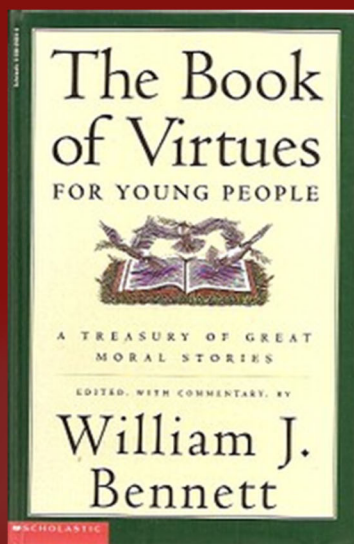

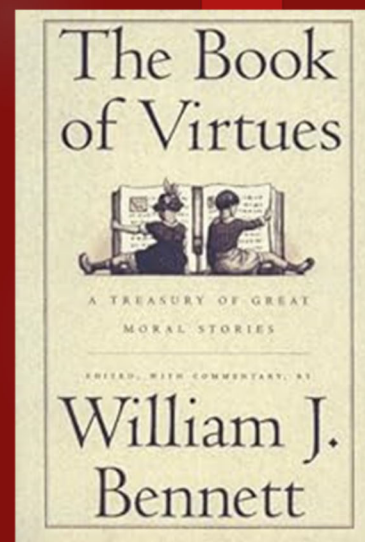


Here are some ideas to consider:

- **Choose a family member and become their "secret saint"** by doing hidden good deeds for him or her during this special time of the year. Things like making the bed, leaving little notes of cheer, doing a chore, offering forgiveness, demonstrating patience, offering prayers for them, leaving a treat on their pillow.

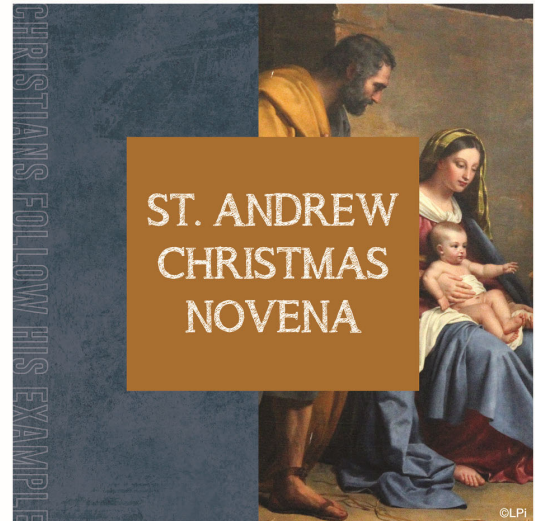

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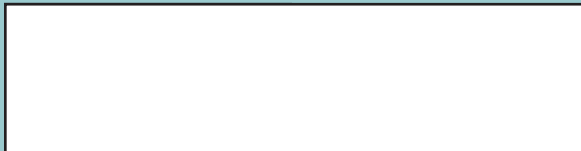
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
