Inspect thermostat.	Inspect thermostat.
Check for combustible material near appliance.	Check disconnect box for proper rating and setup.
Test for gas or fuel leaks.	Inspect compressor wiring connections.
Inspect ignition system for proper operation.	Check contactor for damage.
Test ducts for carbon monoxide.	Inspect safety devices for proper operation.
Check exhaust system venting.	Tighten electrical wiring connections.
Measure supply/return temperature difference.	Test capacitors for proper rating.
Test safety and control circuits.	Inspect condenser coils.
Inspect and clean filter.	Test fan blade balance and operation.
Clean and vacuum heat exchanger.	Check service valves for operation.
Inspect heat exchanger for wear or cracks.	Monitor refrigerant operating pressures.
Lubricate moving parts as needed.	Clean air filter if needed.
Measure blower amperage and voltage.	Test blower motor operation.
Tighten and inspect wiring.	Inspect indoor coil.
Perform combustion and efficiency test.	Clear condensate drain.
Clean appliance exterior.	Measure supply/return temperature differential.
	Check blower motor amperage and voltage.
