Meet will follow all Washington State restrictions and guidelines. Regular updates regarding COVID guidelines will be made starting one month out.

All coaches, staff and non-competing student-athletes are required to wear a mask/neck gaiter. Physical distancing should be employed to the extent possible. All competing student-athletes are required to wear a face mask/neck gaiter during warm-ups and at the starting line which may be removed just prior to the start of competition. Spectators, officials and staff are required to wear masks regardless of vaccination status.

Entry into the 2021 Spokane Invitational is open to college teams. Teams will be given access to enter online at DirectAthletics.com. We will accept as many athletes and teams that we can accommodate in a reasonable schedule. Teams and unattached individuals interested in competing must contact the Meet Director meetdirector@spokanesports.org for permission to enter.

Unattached athletes will be accepted on a limited basis at the discretion of the meet director and must adhere to all COVID protocols. All entries will be online at www.directathletics.com by the entry deadline of Monday December 6th at 5:00pm.

Collegiate Teams: \$500 per gender per team.
Unattached/Individuals: \$40 charge due at time of registration. All entry fees are due at the time of registration on Direct Athletics before the close of entries.

Total rosters and per event limits will not be restricted. However, meet management reserves the right to limit entries per event in order to adhere to time schedule and maintain a manageable environment for competition and COVID protocols.

In addition, meet management reserves the right to select which entries will be accepted and in which sections entrants will be placed.

Accepted entries will be announced Tuesday December 7th by 5:00pm. Heat sheets will be posted Thursday December 9th.

Packet Pickup is located in the Multipurpose Room on the main level of The Podium. Packet Pickup is open on Friday from 1:00pm-6:00pm and Saturday from 8:00am-12:00pm. Packets contain wristbands/credentials for the entire team and travel party. Please make arrangements to distribute wristbands/credentials before entering the facility. Athletes/travel party will not be permitted to enter the facility without proper access credentials.

All tickets are general admission and first come first serve. Tickets are available for purchase at The Podium ticket window located outside of The Podium outside main spectator entrance. Ticket pricing is \$10/adult, and \$5 for children under 12 and students with valid school ID's.

Certified Athletic Trainers will be available for limited services. Modalities available when requests are made in advance. Acute and urgent care of injuries will be provided to visiting athletes. Heat and ice available to athletes.

Warm up area is located adjacent to the competition floor and is only accessible from the stairs or main elevator located by the entrance of The Podium. Only student-athletes, coaches, officials and designated staff will be allowed on warm-up level. Due to COVID regulations, meet management reserves the right to limit persons in warm up space.

The Podium will be open for practice on Friday, December 10th from 1:00pm-6:00pm, and Saturday, December 11th from 8:00am-10:00am.

Implement Inspection is located on the Warm-Up Level of The Podium. Weigh in will open Saturday, December 11th two hours prior to competition. All implements must be checked in at least 90 minutes prior to event competition. All implements must meet all NCAA rules and regulations.

Locations for coaches boxes and areas will be sent out with final schedule and accepted entries.

Check-In

The clerking check-in is located on the Warm-Up level of The Podium. Final declarations for all events will occur at the check-in with the clerk at least 30 minutes prior to running events. Field events will check in at the clerk and be allowed to proceed to the competition site prior to the start of the event. Specific warmup times and field access will be included in final meet info emailed the week of the event.

Spikes

Only **1/4" Pyramid** spikes are allowed on all running and jumping surfaces. Spikes will be checked and those not meeting the regulations must be replaced. No pin/needle/Christmas tree spikes will be allowed on the competition floor or warm-up area.
