# WHAT IS NEXT FOR 2026?

God has prepared an exciting missionary journey to South Korea and Japan in April 2026, and our hearts are overflowing with expectation! He has clearly highlighted these two nations as the place to begin—preaching the Gospel, praying for physical and emotional healing, declaring freedom over the oppressed, restoring captive hearts, and boldly believing for resurrection life to be released through His power. Our plan is to work with Local churches doing outreach, and other activities with them to show God’s love.

Last March, God spoke to us about entering a transitional season—one marked by three distinct phases within our missionary assignment. Since that moment, we have remained fully committed, saying “yes” to every opportunity to serve, build, and advance His Kingdom wherever He opens the door.

This will be our second missionary trip to Asia, and we are incredibly expectant for how God will move this time! In November 2023, we spent four weeks in Japan and South Korea on a reconnaissance trip. During that season, God allowed us to form powerful, divine connections—relationships that we are now ready to revisit, strengthen, and partner with as we work together for the Kingdom. We’re sharing some photos that haven’t been seen before from that previous Asia trip, and they remind us of one powerful truth: God is just getting started. We believe this next journey will carry even greater impact, because as His children, we move from victory to victory. Amen! We are ready, expectant, and excited for all that God is about to do.



These are some of the main reasons God has clearly placed South Korea and Japan on our hearts during this season:

## **South Korea**

South Korea is going through a very complex spiritual moment. Life moves fast, expectations are high, and cultural values are shifting quickly—especially among the younger generation. While people are still open to spirituality, many are moving away from biblical foundations. Issues like loneliness, mental health struggles, gender tension, and suicide (one of the highest rates in the world) are deeply impacting society.

Even the government has recognized this need, launching initiatives like “Seoul Without Loneliness” to address isolation and “lonely deaths.” Yet during our mission trip in November 2023, local Korean believers shared something very real with us: many young people are no longer interested in building their lives around the Bible. What they truly need isn’t another system or program—they need Jesus, and a real encounter with the Holy Spirit that brings identity, healing, and hope.

## **Japan**

Japan’s spiritual journey is deeply shaped by its history. Early Christianity was strongly persecuted, followed by over 250 years of isolation. When the country reopened, Christianity had lost its cultural roots and came to be seen as something foreign. Today, faith is often personal and non-exclusive, and social harmony is valued more than individual belief, which makes open Christian commitment difficult.

Because of this, our assignment in Japan is very relational. We come alongside local churches, serving together as extra hands and feet to share the Gospel—not as a forced religious system, but as a real, meaningful relationship with God, our Creator and Savior. Japan doesn’t need religion; it needs an encounter with God’s love.

Why this matters

- South Korea: ~31% Christian
- Japan: ~0.7–1.5% Christian
- Nepal: ~1.7–1.8% Christian

These numbers aren’t just statistics—they represent real people, real stories, and hearts God deeply loves. This is why we go, why we serve, and why we invite you to partner with us in prayer and support. Together, we get to be part of what God is doing across nations—and that’s something truly special.

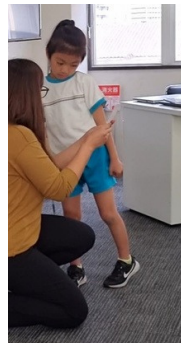


# VISITING AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AT OITA, JAPAN
