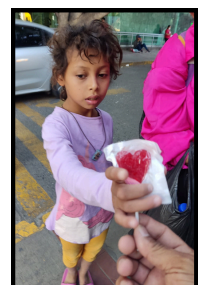
Update of Reyes's mother-in-law the next time A.W. visited with the family she was keeping food down and totally fine. Praise God!

Others set free from various things that kept them from living their lives completely for the Lord. A.W. ministered at a new work that was started a few months ago. He had other opportunities to share the gospel and pray for people in their homes. We are so thankful for all that God did during this trip. Some churches are asking when A.W. will be returning to Manzanillo. There is a trip that is being planned for next spring.

Gracia Abundante Church was going to get a new roof which started after that Sunday morning service that A.W. preached. They had the church service outside behind the church under the trees at 8 a.m. before it got too hot to be outside and so that work could begin earlier that day.

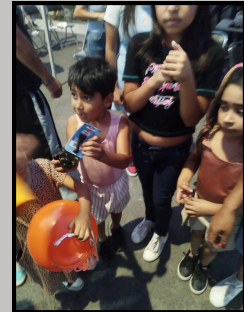
