We hope this month's newsletter encourages you and helps us stay connected and informed with all the current things that God is doing.

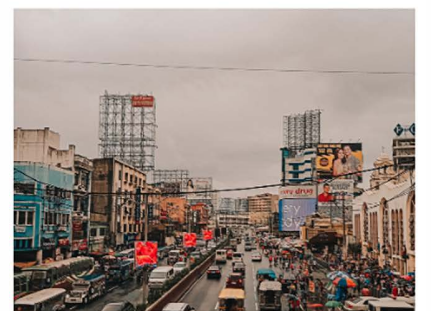


### TRAVEL UPDATE
