



Mandeville Futsal League FAQs

When does registration start?

Registration begins **April 25th** and ends **June 8th (to guarantee a spot)**.

How do I register?

SIGN UP INDIVIDUALLY.

The league's goal is to provide a new soccer experience for ALL. The league organizer will form the teams with the goal of creating a fair playing level for all players/ teams in the league. This format will protect the integrity of the league and avoid stacked teams.

When are the games?

Futsal League will be a winter league. The futsal matches will be on **Sundays** starting **June 14th**, and ending with a futsal tournament on **August 2nd**.

League playdates will be on June 14th, June 21st, July 12th, July 26th and August 2nd (futsal play-off tournament August 2nd)

Schedules and Teams will be released on June 11th, 2026.

How much to participate in the league and join a team?

The cost per player is \$120.

The cost provides each player/team:

- 8 league games plus a tournament
- Referees for every match
- League organization format and supervision
- Air-conditioned Indoor facilities
- All futsal equipment to run the league
- End of the league tournament
- Awards for league champions

Do we need uniforms?

No, Players can wear any attire. The League organizers will provide soccer vests to distinguish between teams.

How many players play in a futsal game?

Futsal will be 5v5 (4 field players and a GK)

What is the recommended amount for a team roster?

The ideal number of players for a futsal team in the league is 7 players, and the maximum number of players is 9. The league organizer will do their best to strike a balance of not placing too many players on a team but will make sure each team has enough to counteract some of your **teammate's vacations during the holidays.**

What are the divisions?

The Futsal league will be divided into age group brackets aiming to have a boy's division and a girl's division in each age group. Each division will consist of 4-6 teams.

U13/U14 BOYS

*Please note that the League may opt to have a co-ed division in order for the league to take place for those players registered.

How many games do we play in the League?

Each team will get a minimum of 6-8 bracket games plus a league tournament.

Each team will play **2 games each on Sunday.**

What equipment do I need for indoor Futsal?

The Futsal League will provide game balls, facilities, and referees. **Players only need to bring appropriate flat indoor soccer shoes or tennis shoes and Shinguards.**

NO Cleats are allowed!

Other things to know:

- Concessions will be available
- Flexible attendance
- No chewing gum is allowed in the gym
- No cleats are allowed
- No sunflower seeds in the gym
- No regular soccer balls allowed
