



PARTNERING WITH HOPE

Hope Through Education is an independent 501(c)(3) that provides economically disadvantaged children living in Hunterdon, Middlesex, Somerset, and Warren counties partial tuition scholarships to attend quality, value-based schools. Scholarships are based on need without regard to gender, race, religion, or ethnic background.

Hope Through Education offers the following annual tuition scholarships:

- \$2,500 for Grades K-8
- \$4,500 for Grades 9-12

Students qualified for tuition scholarship assistance:

- Must live in Hunterdon, Middlesex, Somerset, or Warren Counties in NJ.
- Must submit completed financial aid forms to FACTS by MARCH 31.
- Tuition scholarships are awarded to the neediest applicants as determined by FACTS.

HOW SCHOOLS PARTNER WITH HOPE

Schools submit the following information with cover letter to HOPE.

1. Accreditations
2. Grade levels/enrollment
3. Tuition
4. Existence of financial aid program; and
5. School mission, including evidence of values-based curriculum or policies such as an Honor Code, Peer Mentoring Program, Community Service program, and any other curriculum related to building character and respecting others.
6. If approved, schools will be added to our *Partner Schools* list, and we will inform FACTS.

HOW THE SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS WORKS

Tuition scholarships are awarded via the following process:

1. Students apply for financial aid through FACTS.
2. HOPE accesses applications through FACTS reviewing them for scholarships.
3. The student application deadline is MARCH 31.
4. Student families and schools will be notified of decisions by JUNE 15.
5. HOPE sends tuition scholarship payments directly to schools by NOVEMBER 30.
