Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal. You will only need your straight stitch.

Rotary Cutter and mat

Iron and pressing mat. There are irons in the classroom you can also use.

Add a Quarter Ruler

Thread snips

Pen and paper for notes

Lunch

Fabric

This is a real scrap buster! Because nothing is cut to size any size scrap can be used.

I used all different whites on one side and all my colorful scraps on the other side. All the geese were made of different blacks.

Gather up all your scraps, cut up fat quarters, left overs from other quilts, all that stuff you don't know what to do with and let's get busy!

This quilt calls for 36 paper patterns per student. There is a \$5.00 charge (payable to teacher) to cover printing, paper, etc.
