

## Guide Class Part 1, Part 2, and Part 3

Come and learn the anatomy of your serger and the basic stitch formation followed with practice / hands-on with overlock stitches during Part 1 and 2 sessions. Part 3 will cover the coverstitch and chain stitches.

Bring:

- Your serger and all the accessories that came with it - remember the cord and foot. Bring the manual and threading card/information.
- Basic sewing supplies – snips, a lead pencil, six-inch ruler, seam ripper, Clover clips, flower head pins (or other flat headed pins), seam sealant.
- One cone/spool of thread that matches the threading pathways – red, blue, green, and yellow for overlock. Bring one cone of purple thread for Guide Class #3. Thread may be polyester or cotton – your choice, just make sure the thread is the same fiber content for the four cones/spools. Best not to mix and match the fiber content for the guide class segment.
- Each attendee will receive fabric for the stitch samples.
- Visit ‘A Different Touch’ website and on the home page, select the tab for the Mastery Workbook files located on top. Find the workbook that corresponds to your serger. Print it. If you experience trouble printing, do let me know, and I will bring a copy for you.
- As a suggestion to stay organize, use a binder to place the Mastery Book pages in document protector sleeves for the serged samples. The binder becomes your reference book to add techniques learned.
