

## Supply List:

Sewing Machine (in good working order)

Manual for your sewing machine

Rotary Cutter - 45m.m.

Mat for rotary cutting

Pins (I love Clover Red Tip Pins)

Seam Ripper

Scissors for snipping threads

Rulers - start with a 12" square and a 8 x 12. I recommend Creative Grid rulers

Travel Iron (not required there are irons in the classroom you can use)

Wool Pressing Mat (Only if you have a travel iron)

Thread for piecing (I use a med. gray as it tends to blend into most fabrics)

### **Fabric:**

Find one print that you love. Make sure it has plenty of colors in it you can pull from. If you look at the sample the main fabric is in all the blocks and is also the border.

You will need:

2 yards of "main" fabric

Fat Quarters of at least 4 different colors (those colors are what you are seeing in your main fabric)

Buy your fat quarters in light, medium, and dark. (The staff at the quilt shop can help you with this)

Later on in the class we will talk about sashing fabric - backing fabric - batting and binding. You do not need to purchase these yet.
