

Supply List for Beginning Machine Applique

- Sewing Machine – If you don't have specialty stitches that's fine. You can use your zig zag stitch.
- Scissors to cut paper
- Fabric Scissors

Iron and wool pressing pad – If you don't have these there are irons in the classroom. ** Note- The small travel irons do NOT get hot enough to melt the glue on the Steam A Seam. You may want to bring a bigger iron or use the ones in the classroom. I will bring my steam iron from home.

- Thread that matches the fabric – If you have a colorful fabric, you have a lot of choices.
- **BEFORE CLASS** Cut 3 of your background fabrics at 12" square before class. If you want 3 different backgrounds cut 1 -12" square out of those three fabrics
 - 1 yard of Steam a Seam
 - Fabric Markers such as a Frixon Pen or a disappearing marker.
- **FABRIC:**
 - 1 yard of background fabric
 - 1 yard total of several different fabrics for the borders.
 - For the teapots and the cups you will need scraps or fat quarters. The blocks are 9" so it's not a lot of fabric. My suggestion is to look at the picture and imagine it in your colors and fabrics. Pick what you love!
