This work won't be finished until next year, but it was a good place to layover while we await final permits for the new work coming in Arkansas, that we hope to start mid-May.

On a more personal note: My wife's family is still doing well, and we are thankful for all the prayers for them. However, our dog Lilly has turned to a life of crime, she is now a "pup-vict" having been arrested in Panama City for excessive, licking of a police officer!

The church in Panama City provides an open door policy for the police department, providing snacks and clean restrooms. We got to make a new friend and thankfully a kind one too as this was the first time we have had a family member returned to us in a police car.

Thank you all for your faithfulness in prayer and support. God is so good to us to give us such wonderful people to work with!

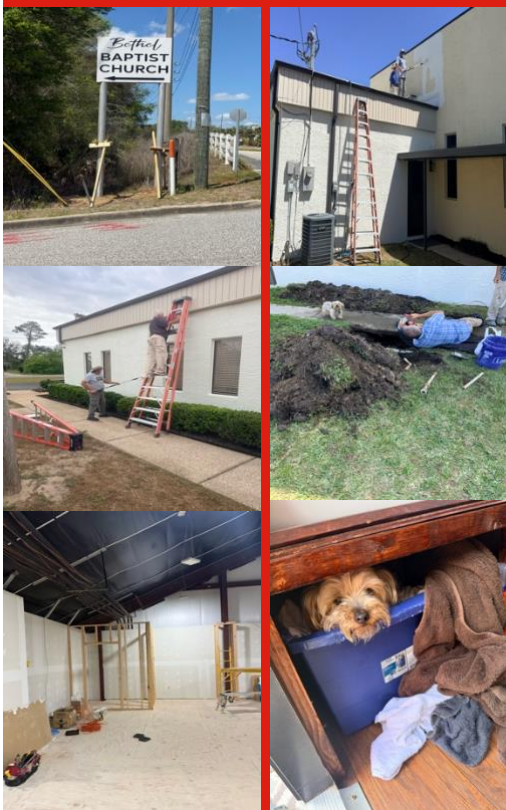
