Just before Valentine's Day, we moved on to High Springs Florida, to Victory Springs Baptist Church with Pastor Patrick Gimenez. The church here was started approximately eight years ago and has been meeting in a very small storefront, that they have far outgrown and are now renting a second storefront just to handle the children, even using a bus as a Sunday school room to get by. They've been diligently working on their new building for the past four years as the Lord has provided, and we're at the sheet rock phase and installation of heat and air units. This is where we came in. Our task was to help hanging the 5/8 drywall throughout the building, especially the high walls where it was difficult for the older men of the church to work on. We only had a couple of weeks allotted for this with the other work that's been scheduled so it's been a real push to get all this done, but the folks here at High Springs are hard workers and God has immensely blessed. Praise the Lord for his wonderful grace! By the time you receive this letter, though our time here will be done and will be moving on to a new work in Hernando, Florida, where we look forward to what God has for us.

On a more personal note:

My Wife was able to come visit for a short while over Valentine's Day as she is still caring for her parents back in North Carolina. Please continue to pray for them and for her as she seeks God's will as to how long she might need to stay.

Also during the past month, my wife's brother lost his house and everything he had to a fire. Though it was a rental house and the owner had the house covered. He didn't have any insurance for what was inside, but God's been good and we've been blessed to watch his hand working in my brother-in-law's life. Please continue to pray for him as he recovers from this tragedy.
