Dear friends and co-laborers

The month of June has now passed, and it was definitely jammed full!

We have spent the past five weeks now working diligently here at New Horizon Baptist Church, with, Pastor, Kevin, Bernard. As we mentioned in our last letter, we had just moved in before the end of the month and started work on their new Sunday school and gymnasium building. The original plan was for us to install the plumbing in the walls for the new bathrooms and the new prophets chambers for both the first and second floor. This work was supposed to only take a couple of weeks and we were intending on moving to Paragould Arkansas to do a slab rough for Pastor, Stacy Prater, at Bible Baptist Church.

However, I'm not sure whose prayers were being answered, as Brother Kevin was praying we would stay and Brother Stacy was praying we would be able to start! The Lord has everything in control though brother Stacy had some problems with rain and a foundation that couldn't get done when he had planned, so that left us the opportunity to continue working for Brother Kevin, which was probably best if he is going to have any chance of having the school open in time for the August 6 open house.

As of this point, we have completed hanging the sheet rock on the second floor, which is where the classrooms will be for this year. All the plumbing has been roughed in throughout the entire building and passed inspection.

Just to give you an idea of the scope of the work; there are two gang bathrooms downstairs, two single bathrooms upstairs, a small one bedroom prophet chamber with a bathroom and shower, one large two bedroom prophet chamber with a bathroom, shower, kitchen and washing machine. There is also a full janitor's closet with a second washing machine and dryer for the gymnasium area, along with a full commercial sized kitchen. I wish I could say that's all we had to get done, but there's so much more to do! We managed to help them wire over half the downstairs area, including both prophets chambers, installing exhaust fans, dryer ducts, blocking for about everything you can imagine, wiring and drains for mini splits and HVAC units on the second floor! Praise the Lord! All of this is being done debt free for the glory of God, and the preaching of the gospel!

But our stay here has to come to an end for now as Paragould is ready to start, and by the time you get this letter, that's where we'll be.

On a more personal note, Lily is back to mope-ing again; as once again, my wife had to return home to help with her dad as his condition is worsening. Please continue to pray for her and for her family, as the stress of caring for him grows as his Parkinson's progresses. Thank you again for your prayers and support, as we would be unable to continue without it!

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
