



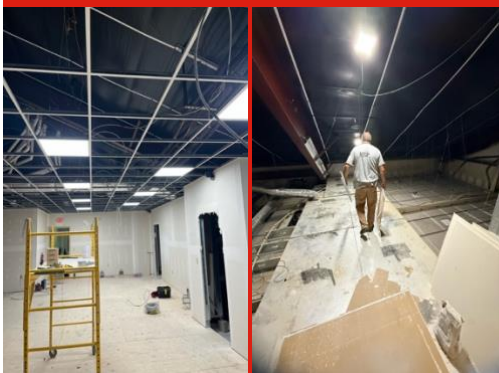

Another month has past serving our Lord, it's hard to believe just how fast time flies. especially when you began to look back and wonder, what did we accomplish? Could more have been done? The month of May started out continuing our work at Union City Baptist Temple, in Tennessee, where we were installing a new ceiling for what will soon be a teen class and recreation area on the second floor. It was not far into May before we realized that this particular project was not gonna take long so the Pastor went ahead and purchased all new lighting so that we could wire them in as well. Even so with the additional work of the lighting, the project was moving along quickly, so it was decided it was a good time while we were still waiting on the job in Paragould Arkansas to take a trip back home, to see the family, say hi to our Church family, and spend a great deal of money with doctors appointments so that they would renew our prescriptions. What a wonderful blessing was to be able to make the trip!

We were only gone for a little over a week but during that time the Pastor found more work for us to do. It's amazing how easy it is to find work around the church house!

The new project turned out to be enlarging the door into the fellowship hall from the storage room. This room is used primarily for table and chair storage, however, the racks for the chairs were taller than the door and required the chairs to be removed and carried rather than simply pushing racks as intended for loading and unloading.

By the end of May, we were all but finished with the projects however the Church plant in Paragould was still not ready.

Thankfully, the Lord had that covered, as just four hours down the road in Ward, Arkansas was another church that was building a gymnasium and classroom edition. They are hard pressed for time to finish the classrooms before the new school year starts. From what we understand sometime in the past few years Arkansas started subsidizing private school for any child that wanted to go, without limiting the bible curriculum that could be taught to the children at that school. Praise the Lord! The children have a safe place to learn and are being taught the truth!

Please pray for us and for help in the field, as both the job in Ward and the job in Paragould will be running at the same time and will be going back-and-forth between them!

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
