

## S.H.O.C.K. will meet twice a month on Sundays from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. and once a month at an additional time. A schedule will be provided.

**S.H.O.C.K.** is for youth in grades 9 to 12. Confirmation parents, please note that the parent meetings will include extra parent/child classes to assist families in helping us to prepare their child for the sacrament.

## Students in 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades MUST meet attendance requirements of no more than 4 unexcused absences.

- ❖ Participation in the Mass is an important part of active participation in your faith. A student who is active in the faith is one who participates regularly in the classes and religious activities for their grade AND who participates regularly in the Sunday Mass.
- ❖ Participation in all activities of the Pre-Confirmation and Confirmation classes is mandatory in preparing for the sacrament.
- ❖ We will gather in the Parish Center at 5:00 P.M. for prayer, food and fellowship and various activities designed to help us build community and grow in relationship with Jesus Christ. We will conclude our gatherings at 7:00 P.M.
- ❖ The doors will be locked 15 minutes into the gathering and students will have to knock to be admitted by the security team.
- ❖ Students are not to leave during class time unless checked out from the DRE or YM by a parent or unless previous arrangements have been made with the DRE or YM.
- ❖ DROP OFF / PICK UP POLICY -- With the child's safety in mind, students must be signed in and out of class by a parent, guardian, or another parent-approved person listed on the child's registration. High school students may sign themselves in and out so the parents do not need to get out of their vehicles.
  - > Drop off is at 5:00 P.M. at the Parish Center.
  - ➤ Pick up is at 7:00 P.M. at the Parish Center.
  - > For security reasons, please use only the brown door at the Parish Center. For other venues, please use the main door, unless otherwise specified.
  - Please make every effort to drop off / pick up your child on time. When they are late to class, this is a disruption to the other students in the class as well as a disruption to your child's formation. When you are late to pick them up, at least two EIM-certified adults must wait with your child (per Diocese guidelines).
- ❖ Additional SHOCK activities include the leadership team, the Christmas pageant, DCYC, Godstock, Teen ACTS, Pro-Life Rally, and Catholic Heart WorkCamp. Participation in the additional activities is encouraged for your child's faith growth.
