Zoom™ Virtual Attendance Instructions

The following guidelines apply to any student participating in our live interactive Zoom™ classes, as mandated by the Nebraska Real Estate Commission (NREC).

- **Direct Zoom Link:** The link to join this CE class via Zoom™ can be found in the Confirmation Email sent right after you register for this course! We will also send a reminder email the day before the class with the same details.
- **ZOOM APP:** We strongly advise against using the Zoom™ App, as it frequently requires updates and may not function properly if the app is outdated.
- **Entering Class:** Click on the Zoom™ course link ~10 minutes before the scheduled class start time. **Please BE ON TIME!**
- **Time Zone:** Verify that your device time and time zone are set correctly.
- **Your Technology:** Verify that your technology works correctly before class.

Note: *We cannot provide individual technical support immediately before or during the class.*

- **Acceptable Devices:** You need a workstation, laptop, or tablet. Smartphones are not permitted for the interactive segments of these sessions. However, you may use them for visual participation if your computer lacks a webcam. Please use headsets or earbuds if you have them.
- **Verification:** The NREC may visit us unannounced during any class that requires attendance using visual confirmation. You must be punctual and always be present, both visually and audibly, to qualify for a class certificate! NREC regulations - **NO exceptions!**

- **During Class:** Please focus and participate as though you were in an actual classroom setting. All student microphones must be muted unless speaking during class. Please remember to mute your microphone when you're not speaking.
- **Distractions:** While in class, limit distractions like background noise, pets, side conversations, eating, children, and other possible interruptions.
