USA Swimming Membership Requirements: All competition entrants must be active registered members in good standing of USA Swimming.

Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border" policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity in this meet must be coach members of USA Swimming. All participating coaches and officials are required to show proof of current USA Swimming membership in good standing for the membership category in which they are participating. All coaches and officials are required to sign in with the Clerk of Course and/or all coaches and officials must be prepared to show their USA Swimming membership at any time to the Meet Director and/or Meet Referee.

On-deck registration is allowed at this competition.

Coach Supervision: All athletes participating in this meet must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warmdown. Arrangements for such supervision must be made prior to the meet and are the responsibility of the athlete.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Participant Protection Policies: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cellphone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
