The committee also addresses specific concerns and challenges that often accompany aging and works to help ensure that older adults have access to the resources and support they need.

The South Orange Village Council is represented on SOSAC by a Council member who attends meetings as a non-voting representative. SOSAC also works closely with the SOMA Two Towns for All Ages Coordinator, who attends monthly meetings, provides updates, and helps implement a comprehensive array of programs and services for older adults.

Meetings are open to the public, and members of the community are encouraged to attend and participate.
