As you are aware, your child will take the LEAP Assessment (Louisiana Educational Assessment Program) next week. 4th and 5th graders will test from May 6 to May 12, 2026, with make-up testing on May 13th and 14th. The table below lists the CBT (Computer-Based Testing) administration schedule for each subject and the duration of each session.

During testing, it is important that your child:

- arrive at school on time, no later than 8:30 AM each day. Please give yourself extra time to avoid tardiness. **If students arrive after testing has begun, they will not be allowed to join the test session in progress. They will have to make up for the missed session, and they will be kept separate from their classmates until they have done so.**
- have a good night's sleep.
- eat a nutritional breakfast before arriving at school; or, if your child eats breakfast at school, please plan to have your child here at 8:00 AM so your child has enough time to eat.
- No early check out as possible, only in case of emergency.
- Students **MAY NOT** bring cell phones, smart watches, or other electronics devices to the school (ISL Family Handbook)
