BENTON TOWNSHIP

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

Preparation of Bid:

- (1) Each bid should be submitted on the attached form and
- (2) Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project.

Qualifications of Bidder:

Owner may make such investigation as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work, and the bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work contemplated therein. Conditional bids will not be accepted.

Bid Security:

Each bid must be accompanied by certified check of the bidder, or a bid bond duly executed by the bidder as principal, and having as surety thereon a surety company approved by the Owner, in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the bid. Such checks or bid bonds will be returned to all except the lowest bidder within three (3) days after the bid award, and the remaining check or bid bonds will be returned promptly after the Owner and the accepted bidder have executed the contract and the project has been completed, or, if no award has been made within thirty (30) days after the date of the opening of bids, upon demand of the bidder at any time thereafter, so long as he has not been notified of the acceptance of the bid.

Liquidated Damages for Failure to Enter into Contract:

The successful bidder, upon his failure or refusal to execute and deliver the contract and bonds required within ten (10) days after he has received notice of acceptance of his bid, shall forfeit to the Owner, as liquidated damages for such failure or refusal, the security deposited with his bid.

Completion Date:

Bidder agrees to commence work in a timely fashion after entering into a contract. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed by August 30, 2026.

Failure to complete the project on time will result in the contractor forfeiting \$500.00 per day in liquidated damages for every day after this completion date, unless both the contractor and the County Engineer agree to a time extension and waiver of the liquidated damages due to unforeseen circumstances.

Security for Faithful Performance:

Simultaneously with his delivery of the executed contract, the contractor shall furnish a surety bond or bonds as security for faithful performance of this contract and for the payment of all persons performing labor on the project under this contract, as specified in the General conditions included herein. The surety on such bonds shall be a duly authorized surety company satisfactory to the Owner.

Laws and Regulations:

The bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable State Laws, municipal ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the contract the same as though herein written out in full.

Method of Award - Lowest Qualified Bidder:

If at the time this contract is to be awarded, the lowest base bid submitted by a responsible bidder does not exceed the amount of funds then estimated by the Owner as available to finance the contract, the contract will be awarded on the base bid only. If such bid exceeds such amount, the Owner may reject all bids or may award the contract on the base bid combined with such deductible alternates applied in numerical order which they are listed in the Form of Bid, as produces a net amount which is within the available funds.

Obligation of Bidder:

At the time of the opening of bids each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the plans and contract document (including all addenda). The failure or omission of any bidder to examine any form instrument or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect of his bid.

Material and Work Specifications:

All materials and work shall be in conformance with the latest addition of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation construction and Material Specifications.

GENERAL NOTES

EXTRA AREAS:

Included in the quantity under "X-tra Concrete" is paving at private drives and intersections. All drives shall receive a 2' apron and all intersections shall receive a 10' apron.

TEMPORARY CENTERLINE:

Temporary centerline is to be applied to the finish course.

UNIT PRICE:

The unit prices for items "441 Asphalt Concrete" surface course intermediate course are price per ton, not price per cubic yard. Quantities used for estimating purposes assume 2 tons per cubic yard. However, the tonnage required to meet the mat thicknesses shall be determined at time of construction from the mix formulation (JMF) used on this project.

TRAFFIC:

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to maintain traffic in accordance with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. At no time shall flaggers perform other duties while working on this project.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The locations and corresponding quantities as listed are approximate and should be considered as the base contract. The Hocking County Engineer may add additional locations and quantities to this project at the unit prices bid throughout the 2025 construction season. It may become necessary to cut back on the scope of work on various projects due to lack of required funding.

DISPOSAL OF CUTTINGS:

Cuttings resulting from any planing shall remain the property of the Hocking County Engineer and shall be delivered to the Hocking County Highway garage located at 1286 California Avenue.

PREVAILING WAGE:

This is a prevailing wage project.






