In Memory of President Jimmy Carter

South Shore Habitat for Humanity is joining Habitat for Humanity organizations around the globe in honoring the contributions President Jimmy Carter has made to the organization and to Habitat homeowners. He and Rosalynn Carter served as Habitat for Humanity's most famous volunteers for over 35 years, helping to build affordable housing.

To honor the passing of the late President, South Shore Habitat for Humanity will erect a memorial door for public visitation, symbolic of the many doors opened by President Carter in his work. Members of the public are invited to drop in, and memorialize the late President by writing messages and signing the door. Find us at one of two offered dates:

South Shore Habitat for Humanity was founded in 1986 by members of the United Church of Christ in Norwell, in response to their neighborhood's need for affordable housing and community support. While we are now part of Habitat for Humanity International, and no longer formally associated with the church, we are grateful for their support and our long-term relationship. Members of their church, several of whom are still leading contributors to SSHH, met Jimmy Carter in 1986, at the founding of the organization. Leaders of the Church, including Pastor Leanne Walt, and SSHH Executive Director Erin McGough, will make remarks on the lawn at 1:15 pm.

In 2025, SSHH will also add another build project on Morse Road, in Easton. SSHH staff will be available to discuss the memorial and our work.

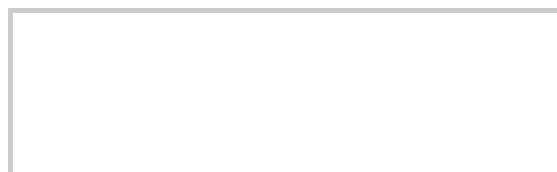
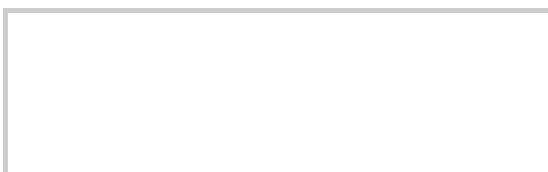

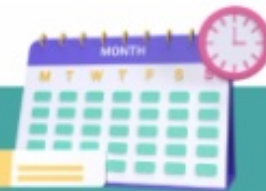
