Program Requirements at a Glance

110 Total Hours Required

Training & Education (approximately 30%)

Sport-specific education, Safe Sport, Ethics, Anti-Racism, Mental Health, Concussion Training, Disability Coaching (Mostly e-learning).

Hands-On Experience (approximately 70%)

Coaching or officiating games and practices.

Complete in your own time during grade 10, 11 and 12.

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
