GENERAL PRICE LIST

These prices are effective as of *January 13, 2026* and are subject to change without notice.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) and the New York State Department of Health both require that certain disclosures be made by funeral providers on the general price list. Although these disclosures are similar, they are not exactly the same. This general price list contains both sets of the required disclosures. The disclosures required by the FTC, when different from those required by the Department of Health, are preceded by the letters "FTC".

The goods and services shown are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected.

This list may not include prices for certain items that you select, such as cemetery charges or crematory *services*, flowers and newspaper notices. The estimated or final prices for those items will be shown on the itemized statement describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected. We charge you for our services in buying certain items.

(FTC) - "The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements that you select will include a charge for our services. If legal or other requirements mean you must pay any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected".

(FTC) - "This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers, and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected".

ALTERNATIVE SERVICES:

The following charges for direct burial and direct cremation do not include additional items or services, merchandise, facility use, and livery that the customer may wish to select.

DIRECT CREMATION

Prices range from:\$ 3,200

which includes the local transfer of remains to the funeral home, staff services, securing of necessary authorizations, basic local transportation to the crematory, an alternative container for cremation, (Oversized Cremation Container Additional \$150) and the return of the cremains to the funeral home.

to:\$ 3,100

-which includes the services as described above but with the cremation container/casket supplied or selected by the customer.

-which includes the services as described for Direct Cremation but with the use of an unfinished wood box. \$ 4,000

NOTE: Direct Cremation prices above **DO NOT** include the crematory charge.

(FTC) "If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you may use an unfinished wooden box or an alternative container. Alternative containers can be made of heavy cardboard, pressed wood or composition material (with or without an outside covering), or may be pouches of canvas or other materials."

NOTE: Alternative cremation container we provide is made of cardboard material.

DIRECT (Immediate) BURIAL

Prices range from:\$ 4,300

which includes the local transfer of remains to the funeral home, staff services, securing of necessary authorizations, basic local transportation to the cemetery, and an alternative container (unfinished Pine).

to:\$3,100

which includes the services as described above but with the alternative container/casket supplied or selected by the customer.

NOTE: Direct burial prices **DO NOT** include cemetery charges.

TRANSFER OF REMAINS to the funeral establishment including equipment and vehicle.

Local: transfers within 15-mile radius.....	\$	400

PREPARATION OF REMAINS:

Embalming (including use of preparation room):	\$	800
Embalming of Autopsied remains:	\$	950

NOTE: In New York State, embalming is not required by law. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for embalming such as direct cremation or direct burial. If you select certain funeral arrangements such as viewing or an open casket funeral, embalming may be required by the funeral firm.

(FTC) – “Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.”

OTHER PREPARATION (excluding embalming):

Preparation of remains, unless selected, is not required for direct cremation or for immediate burial.

a. Topical Disinfection (including use of the preparation room):	\$	250
b. Custodial Care (charged per day after 24-hours):	\$	100
<u>NOTE:</u> Custodial Care will not be charged on the days when embalming or other preparations of the remains occur, visitation is held or a funeral service is conducted.		
c. Dressing /Casketing:	\$	300

f. Care of remains received from outside funeral home:	\$	175

BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF: \$ 2350

Our fee for the basic services of Funeral Director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies others as required. Also included in the charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, secretarial and administrative expenses.

(FTC) – “This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)”

LIMITED SERVICES:

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME: \$ 3,100

This charge includes the local transfer of the remains to the funeral home, staff services, securing necessary authorizations, local transportation to point of shipment. The charge does not include shipping charges, shipping container (if needed) or additional items of service, merchandise, facility use and livery that the customer may wish to select.

Transportation beyond local point of shipment will be billed either as livery or common carrier charges pending upon the forwarding location. Local point of shipment is within a 15 mile radius. Additional mileage is billed at \$4.00 per mile.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME:\$ 3,100

This charge includes basic local transportation of the remains to the funeral home and or place of local disposition, staff services, and securing of necessary authorizations. The charge does not include additional items of service, merchandise, facility use, and livery that the customer may wish to select

Transportation beyond a local place of disposition will be billed as livery charges. Local place of disposition is up to or within 15 mile radius. Additional mileage billed at \$4.00 per mile.

RECEIVING CREMATED REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME....\$ 1380

This charge includes services of basic arrangements with funeral director, use of facilities, supervision for visitation and supervision for memorial service.

It does NOT INCLUDE: urn, memorial cards, register book and other misc. items.
