## **Guidelines on how to choose a Confirmation Sponsor**

To help the confirmation Candidates, choose an appropriate sponsor, I have taken the following information from the Diocesan Confirmation Guidelines.

- The sponsor <u>represents the larger Catholic Community</u> in the Sacrament of Confirmation. It is the role of the sponsor to assist in enabling the confirmed person to live a full Christian life and to carry out faithfully the commitments of the sacrament.
- To underline the connection between baptism and confirmation, as well as the ongoing commitments of sponsorship, the original <u>baptismal</u> <u>Godparent</u> could be invited to be the sponsor for confirmation when this is possible.
- 3. So that the role of sponsorship may be realistically and meaningfully expressed, the designated sponsor <u>should be present</u>, as far as possible, for the celebration of the sacrament. (Canon #892).
- 4. <u>To act as sponsor</u>, a person must be a Catholic who has received all the Sacraments of Initiation, which are Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation, and lives a life consistent with the role being undertaken.
- 5. Since the role of sponsor involves maturity and wisdom in matters of faith, prospective sponsors are to be at least <u>18 years of age</u>.
- 6. There should be <u>a sponsor for each</u> candidate. Male or female sponsors may be chosen without regard to whether the candidate is male or female. Parents or Spouses/significant others cannot be sponsors for the person to be confirmed.
