Cost Estimation is the process of estimating all expenses and incidentals associated with completing a project within scope and according to its timeline.

A thorough cost estimate should include both the direct and indirect costs associated with bringing a project through to completion.

Professional estimators use defined techniques to create cost estimates that are used to assess the financial feasibility of projects, to budget for project costs, and to monitor project spending.

An accurate cost estimate is critical for deciding whether to take on a project, for determining a project's eventual scope, and for ensuring that projects remain financially feasible and avoid cost overruns. Many costs can appear over the life cycle of a project, and an accurate estimation method can be the difference between a successful plan and a failed one. Level 1: Order of Magnitude Level 2: Feasibility Level 3: Preliminary Level 4: Substantive Level 5: Definitive

All these levels are calculated by common methods: Level 1: Analogous, parametric, expert judgment and factoring Level 2: Parametric and factoring Level 3: Bottom-up – unit cost assembly level Level 4: Bottom-up – unit cost detailed Level 5: Bottom-up – unit cost detailed

CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATE CLASSIFICATIONS

1. Design Estimates – prepared during the project's pre-design and design phases, which commences with an order of magnitude to evaluate if the project is viable.

2. Bid Estimates – prepared by contractors in effort to win the project.
