Pull Information

Weight Classes

- Scales open at 11:00 AM
- (On Dirt) 1:00 PM
- Entry Fee: \$5.00 per class
- **No Sign up at 1:00 PM**

Each puller will pull from the previous competitors stop until the end of the track. Then the pulls will be in opposite direction until class is completed etc (including pull offs). Next class will start at either end of the track with track grooming between classes

General Rules

- 1. Violation of any rule may constitute a disqualification.**
- 2. Contest will be governed by three or more judges with all decisions being final.**
- 3. Judges may stop and disqualify any operator not operating safely.**
- 4. No crew coaching on tractor (except if minor or rookie driver).**
- 5. Any protests against operators and or equipment by another operator must fill out a grievance form and will be dealt with in a timely manner by officials.**
- 6. Parade rides-Track packing is not permitted. If an operator does not like his/her position, they may reposition once as long as he or she has not hooked to the sled. A full pull will be 12'.**
- 7. Any operator, owner or pit crew disrupting the pull whether in the pits or on the track, will be disqualified from the class in question and subsequent classes for remainder of the event.**

General Rules continued...

- 8. The discretion of the judges and the pulling committee will prevail including Safety, Operation, Equipment, Good Sportsmanship and Common-Sense will be paramount, including spectators and judges as well as participants.**
- 9. Sign ups for the classes must happened by 1:00 pm. You will no longer be able to sign up or switch classes.**
- 10. Hooks must be easily reached by person hooking (No weights blocking hooks).**
- 11. No King of the Hill class.**

Operators of all tractors are responsible for obtaining the rules prior to the start of the pull. All tractors with operators must be weighed prior to registering for a weight class.

Kids over 18 are invited

Parents must be present to sign a disclaimer form.

There is an admission fee to the fair, with a \$5.00 hook fee for each standard pulling class

Weight

1. All weights must be securely mounted. Any weight lost, anywhere on the fairgrounds, in the pit area, or hitched to stone boat will be grounds for disqualification.
2. All tractors shall be weighed with operator. All tractors must be weight out after pulling each class.

Safety

1. Safe operation at all times on the fairgrounds.
2. Tractor must stop immediately upon signal from judge.
3. Tractor must be in neutral when hitching or unhitching and hands in sight of person hooking.
4. No passengers anywhere on the grounds.
5. Hands must remain on control at all times during the pull.

Operators

1. Written permission from a parent if operator is under 18 years of age.
2. One operator per tractor per class.
3. No alcoholic beverages on the fairgrounds.
4. Operator must remain in seat, be in full control and operate in a safe manner at all times.
5. Owner will assume full responsibility for negligence and or accidents.
6. North Haverhill Fair is not responsible for loss of personal property
7. All drivers must sign a liability waiver before pulling.

Pulling

1. Pulling order will be assigned by number drawn at the time of registration for weight class.
2. At least two tractors per class or the class is void.
3. After the first puller of each class has pulled, judges may decide to add or remove weight. (if adjusted) That tractor will pull again. If weight is deemed correct, puller has the option of excepting that pull or repulling at the end of the class.
4. All pulls start with tight hitch, no jerk pulls permitted.
5. Puller allowed two attempts to achieve his/her best pull-on stone boat.
6. Judges have the option of moving the start line between classes.
7. All tractor tires must remain within course boundaries. If the tires leave the boundaries the attempt is not valid and is disqualified.
8. Tractors being repaired or readied for pull missing their turn will pull last, as long as tractor show within a reasonable time.
9. Only two classes per tractor.
10. Draw bar height not to exceed 20”.

Pulling Committee

The pulling committee will review all grievances and all decisions made by the pulling committee will be final.

Judges

No one judge will prevail. It takes a majority decision of three judges to regulate the event. All judges' decisions are final. Anyone disrupting the event or feels they need to argue with the judges after a decision has been made will be escorted off the fairgrounds by fair security.
